The ideal candidate brings a calm, positive presence and has the intuition to read a child's cues, adjust their approach accordingly, and build rapport through gentle structure, creativity, and fun.

This position is a great fit for someone who already works in Special Education, speech therapy, occupational therapy, or ABA—or for a college student preparing for a career in one of these fields. Experience working with neurodivergent children in professional or structured settings is preferred.

This young learner communicates using short utterances and enjoys educational activities like numbers, letters, and early reading. The family would like the nanny to incorporate educational activities at his level into their day with the child. He thrives with caregivers who are patient, observant, and able to support his growth through thoughtful interaction and play. Outings, life skills, and light learning activities may be included as appropriate.
