Submissions which are deemed to be "joke" or "fake" entries can be disqualified from the challenge. Additionally, submissions which promote illegal, illicit, unethical, immoral, or activities which may be considered unworthy of association with the BEN Health Innovation Summit or Rutgers University may be disqualified.
