# High School Planning Guide: Classes

This guide is intended to help families plan classes for high school. The guide uses Jeffco graduation requirements and classes available at The Summit Academy and through Concurrent Enrollment. This guide is intended to be helpful in planning, but all plans will vary depending on all of these factors and more.

The sections below will show the subject, the Jeffco graduation credit requirements, and the classes that can fulfill these requirements.

#### IMPORTANT INFO:

- ➤ All Summit classes earn 1 credit for the year-long class (.5 credits per semester)
- ➤ Aside from Study Hall, all classes at Summit earn 1 credit per year (.5 credits per semester), including Office Aide
- > If a student takes a class where only .5 credits are needed for Jeffco requirements, the first .5 credits will count toward the credits needed for Jeffco requirements, while the second .5 credits will count toward general elective credits
- ➤ High School Writing classes and Literature classes can be taken at the same time each will earn 1 English credit for the year (.5 credits per semester)
- > The classes listed above are the only courses that will count for graduation requirements for each subject (for example, Speech & Debate is not listed because it is an English **elective** credit)
- > Chemistry should be taken either concurrently with Algebra 2, or after Algebra 2 is complete
- ➤ If you are not sure which math course your student is ready for, please ask their teacher what they would suggest and/or have your student take a placement test (curriculum often come with placement tests our textbook coordinator can help find these if needed)
- ➤ Jeffco graduation requirements do not include World Language requirements, however, many colleges want to see 1-2 years of a foreign language on a student's transcript. We offer High School Spanish 1, 2, and 3, as well as American Sign Language 1, 2, and 3. Many colleges accept ASL as a World Language credit, however, it is wise to check with the specific college(s) your student may be interested in.
- > 8th graders may earn high school credit for *Math* (Algebra 1, Geometry) and *World Language* (High School Spanish, American Sign Language) if taken at Summit. No other high school classes taken in 8th grade will earn high school credit.
