

In order to view the total count of how many cookies have been harvested you'll need to download a text editor, any will work as long as you know how to use them. One of the easiest to use is called Notepad++. Its free -

Step 1 - Download and install Notepad++

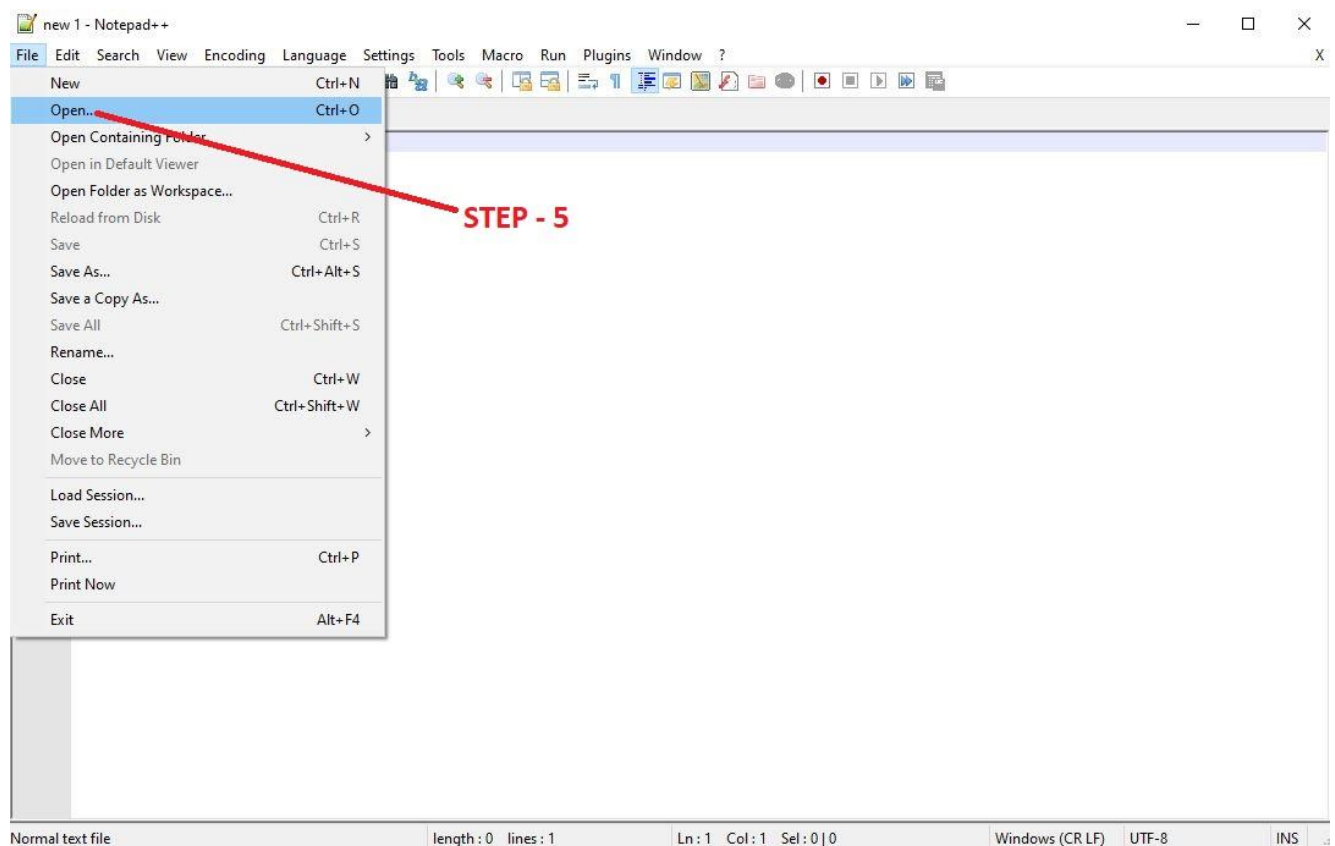
Step 2 - Navigate to the file path as follows

- Windows - C:\users\actual user name
here\AppData\Roaming\NSB\storage\sensorCookies.json
- Mac - /users/actual user name/library/applicationsupport/NSB/storage/sensorCookies.json

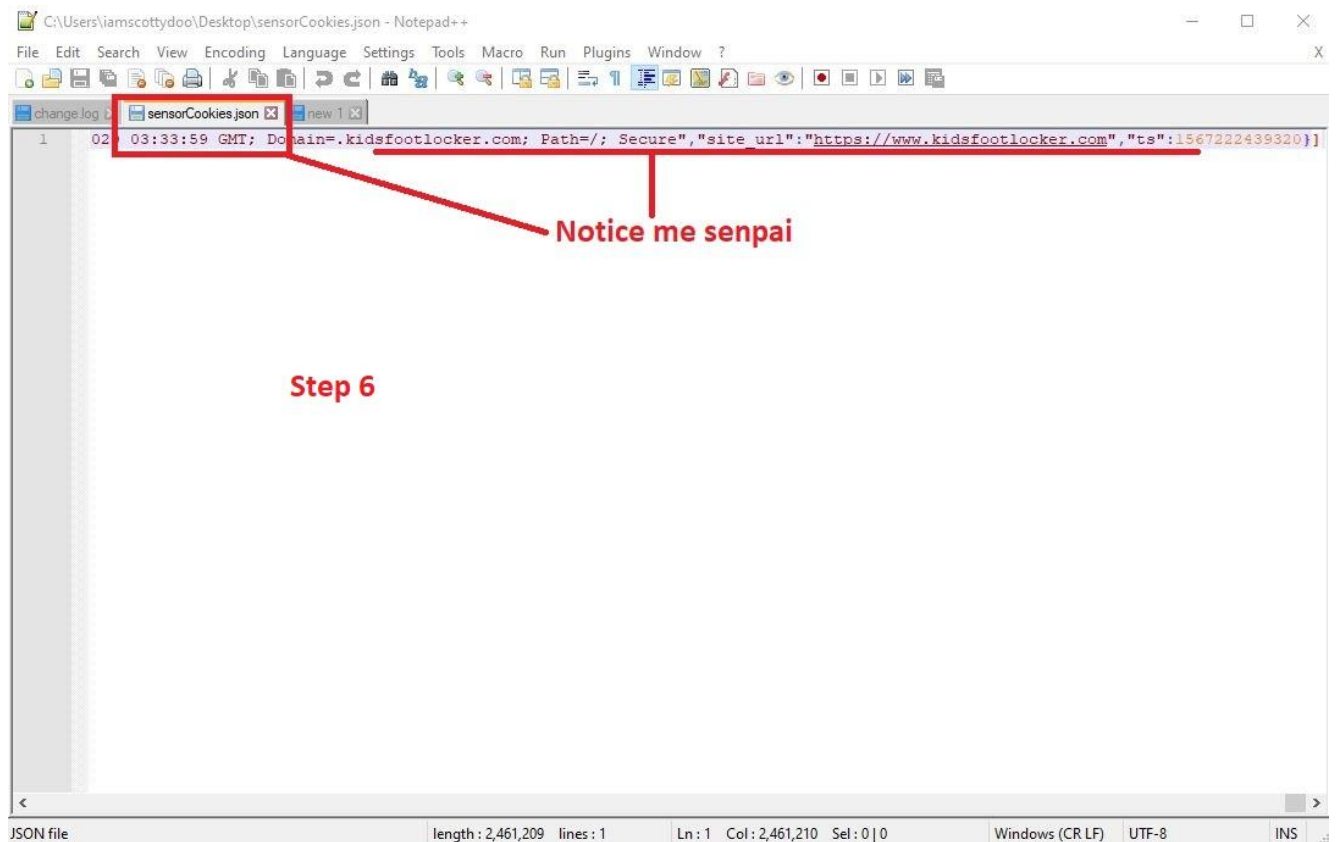
Step 3 - Copy the sensorCookie.json file and save it onto your desktop

Step 4 - Open Notepad++

Step 5 - Select "Open" and select the location that you just saved the sensorCookie.json file (I suggest the desktop so it's easier to find)



Step 6 - Once its open in Notepad++, there will be a tab opened within Notepad++, also you will see that the text from the json file is one long continuous line.

- Hit key CTRL +F (control find) a new window will open up. Make sure you are on the find tab of this window.
- Type the following into the "Find what" field: eastbay.com, footaction.com etc. Make sure you type in the word correctly, if it's misspelled Notepad++ will not pull up and results
- Hit/select "count" and you will see the results of the search on the lower left in blue.
