Carroll CSD Board of Education Directors:

My recommendations for the 2022-2023 Iowa Association of School Board's (IASB) Legislative platform are below. IASB has asked each district to submit four priorities that will be used to develop a legislative platform. It is difficult to narrow the list to four because there are so many important issues that impact our state education system.

Student Achievement and Accountability

- Preschool support continued funding to ensure that all 4 and 5 year-olds have access to the Statewide Voluntary Preschool Program. Support an increase in funding from the current weighting of 0.5 to 1.0 full-time equivalent to increase the ability of the district to provide services such as full-day programming and transportation to ensure that all 4 and 5-year-olds have the ability to attend the Statewide FVoluntary Preschool Program.
- Mental Health Supports efforts to establish comprehensive community mental health systems to offer preventative and treatment services and comprehensive school mental health programs.

Educator Quality

- Market-Competitive Wages supports providing school districts with incentives and the flexibility to pay market competitive wages for shortage area positions, especially in the areas required to meet graduation and Iowa content standards.
- Teacher Recruitment and Licensure supports additional tools to attract individuals to the teaching profession, especially for shortage areas (see the IASB document)

Fiscal Responsibility and Stewardship

- Supplemental State Aid Supports setting supplemental state aid:
 - At a rate that sufficiently supports local districts' efforts to plan, create and sustain world-class schools;
 - For FY 2024, by January 28, 2023
 - For FY 2025 and future budget years, at least 14 months prior to the certification of the school district's budget.
