The group will also visit the Pre-Trial Intervention (PTI) Office, which handles diversion programs for first-time offenders, allowing them to avoid formal court proceedings. Additional stops include the Child Support Office, the Drug Court Office, and the Terrebonne Children's Advocacy Center, where staff support victims of crime and address school-related issues such as truancy and family services.

During the experience, students will learn how cases enter the unit—whether through the patrol division, the Department of Children and Family Services, or community walk-ins—and how each case is reviewed and assigned to a detective. They will gain insight into the investigative process, including interviews, evidence gathering, coordination with partner agencies, and the compassionate approach required when working with children and families. This job shadow is best suited for mature, responsible students who are interested in law enforcement and driven by a desire to help others.

The 32nd Judicial District Court is a court of general jurisdiction. Judge Dagate presides over a wide range of cases concerning Louisiana civil and criminal law. On the date scheduled students will be able to observe misdemeanor court proceedings, child in need of care civil hearings, and magistrate court - which is the initial court proceeding where the judge reviews reports to determine probable cause and sets bail. Judge Dagate will also take time to allow students to review any warrant request submitted by a police officer, and take them through the process of reviewing civil pleadings filed by attorneys. In addition, students will be allowed the opportunity to speak to court personnel and lawyers attending court.
