Due to painting works taking place in Common Ground, the food service area will be closed from Wednesday 28 August for 3 days, and will reopen on Monday 2 September.

So when you receive a meeting invite, please make sure you RSVP to it and tick the "email organiser" box- they would much rather receive all the emails and know who's going/not going, rather than not knowing at all and having to wait on the day to see.


