

11/19+11/20 Hamlet Test - Perspective reversal **TEST GRADE**

In your folder in **Drive**, create a new document, and title it **Hamlet Test**

Alternate method - Open up **google docs**, click the + sign for a new document, name it **Hamlet Test**, then move it to your folder by clicking the **folder icon** to the right of the title and clicking on your folder name.

You've previously been asked to review your notes, as well as the the play, and choose your favorite character (you may not choose Hamlet or Horatio). Make a list of his or her character traits. Choose 4 scenes in which your character plays a part.

Hopefully you've done that.

Task: (This is a test grade and 1 page = about 250 words)

Between today and the end of tomorrow, your job is to attempt to become your character and write four 1-page journal/diary entries from their point of view (two each day). Please accomplish the following

1. Become your character and write in a way which reflects their personality
2. Include massive amounts of textual detail. In essence, you are reacting privately to situations after they are portrayed in the text. (i.e. "This morning Hamlet walked by, talking to himself, and....")
3. Be creative. Don't just list the events, do so in a way that seems like your character's voice.
4. Alternatively, you may also choose 2 characters and write two journal entries for each if you'd like.
5. You don't need to write exactly like SHakespeare, but make an effort. PLease don't use modern language/slang.
6. Due in your folder by the end of the period
7. If you finish early, grab a textbook and begin reading pages 462-478

HW-

1. Make sure the task from yesterday and today is completed.
2. Read pages 462-478 in the textbook for Friday
