Building Background /connection to prior knowledge: Pupils have learnt the safe use of simple tool at school.

Content:

1. Using of tool or simple machine should be handled with.
2. Simple tools should be washed after use.
3. It should be kept in a safe place free from hurting people.
4. It should be used only in it appropriate place.
5. Simple tools should be kept by house guarance or parent to ensure proper safety.

Evaluation: Teacher ask pupil to:
