

Brand Set-up Guidelines

- 1. Only **beer and cider** lines are to be entered, no wine, sparkling wine, or cocktails as the cleaning cycle is different for these lines. If you add a wine line it will incorrectly show as neglected.
- 2. If it is an **empty line** just waiting for a new keg, record this line as "Empty".
- 3. If it has been empty for a while (months) then let us know and we will lower the number of lines.
- 4. Empty lines need to be at the **bottom of the list**. When we reduce the number of lines, they are removed from the bottom of the list.
- 5. Same brewer rotating taps should be recorded as "Rotating <Brewers name>"
- 6. A rotating tap that changes brewers frequently should be recorded as "Rotating <Brand on tap currently>" This will need to be changed as they happen.
- 7. Direct Draw enter in the brand as "**DD <brand name>**" for example DD Coors Light This way they will be easier to sort and find the DD lines.
- 8. If **one line goes to two different taps** (faucets) only record the one line. If there are two Molson Canadian taps from one keg, then only put down Molson Canadian once.
- 9. If there are **two taps** of Canadian and **each line comes from its own keg** (meaning there are 2 lines and 2 kegs of Canadian) then add it twice.
