**Administrative:**

- Approval of February minutes (Christine) - All reviewed; Wendy approved, Zach 2nd
- Treasurer Report (Zach) - February was a relatively slow month because of the cancellation of the indoor comp. The only addition was the R&K sub sales. We did pretty well for the Pops concert, and that revenue will be in the March report. All reviewed; Toni approved, Lindsay 2nd
- Membership Reports (Lindsay) - We had 4 new members sign up in the last month, but one did ask to be removed today when the email for the meeting went out.
- Music Department Report - Mr. Holgate shared that he feels Saturday's Pops concert was very successful. He was impressed with all the performing groups. Mrs. Smith shared that the 2nd grade is performing at the Learning Expo tomorrow night. The 4th grade will be performing The Princess and the Pea. Mr. Leonowitz said things are going well at GMHS, and the musicals are coming along. GMMS is attending their Broadway trip today.

**Old Business:**

- R&K Sub Sale - About \$1,700 went to student accounts.
- Pops Concert - About \$7,000 in profit. Some feel the second show was too long, so that will be addressed for the future.

**New Business:**

- Senior Awards (May 19, 2026, at 6:00) - Jamie is handling the senior awards. Three faculty members are meeting about the awards tomorrow. Joel would like someone else to speak this year since his daughter is a senior. He'd like to just be a parent. Zach said that he will do it in his place.

- Fundraisers / Committees volunteer needs for 26-27
  - Sponsorship Drive - This would only be for concerts and Pops next year.
  - Strike Up The Bands - This will not be occurring next school year.
  - Craft Show (November 14, 2026) - Mr. Holgate will make sure the school is reserved for that day. Keri will oversee it this year, but needs someone to shadow her this year to take over for the next year. We also need a board member to be in charge of this event. There is a conflict with the date because of work at the GMIS gym. This will have to be discussed at the next meeting. Joel will reach out to Tim in the meantime.
  - R&K Sub Sale - Someone needs to take over for next year to keep this going.
  - Pops Concert - Someone will need to take off the Pops concert for next year.
  - Indoor Competition - If the indoor competition is going to happen next year, someone will have to take it over. Our payment for this year was rolled over to next year when we had to cancel.
- 2026-2027 budget meeting - The board will figure this out to see when everyone can make it.

- Update for GMIS Schedule - Mr. Holgate met with Dr. Hess, and she is open to information and data to look into the schedule for next year. Mr. Leonowitz has been doing an attrition study for the district. The data from GMIS helps make the point that the schedule is detrimental to the music program, and this information was shared with the district. Numerous GMIS parents have contacted the district to express concerns, but they don't feel like they are being heard. Sometimes, their emails are not even replied to. Many parents discussed plans to attend a school board meeting.
