

2019 Perry Abbott Memorial Tournament

Use league Baseball Rules and Regulations if not specified by Modified rule list below.

Please have your teams ready to play before your game start time, this will keep the games on time.

Modified Rules: (* - New rule for 2019)

Pitching Rules:

- * A pitcher can only pitch **5 innings** on Saturday (1 pitch = 1 inning) *(New for 2019)*
- * A pitcher can only pitch **3 innings** on Sunday (1 pitch = 1 inning) *(New for 2019)*
- (Please ask if you are unclear of pitching rules)

Other Rules:

- Coaches will set the example of good sportsmanship and not argue umpire calls.
- Each Team Keeps a score sheet, with pitchers listed, to hand in at the concession stand after last game.
- Each team is responsible to provide a new game ball for each game (have a good, used one available if needed)
- Coaches should not take away this experience from players by bringing a reduce roster in an effort to win games.
- * All players present will get a minimum of one at bat per game. (or 2 on Sat. & 1 on Sun. for 13 + player rosters)
- * Majors - Teams can bat all players. Must bat all if 10 or less. (If 11+ may choose to use substitutions)
- * Minors - Teams can bat all players. Must bat all if 12 or less. (If 13+ may choose to use substitutions)
- Although it is encouraged that all players get to play defensively in each game, it is not required.
- * An injured player is not considered an out in the lineup if team is batting all players.
- Flip coin for Home and Away every game
- Unlimited runs per inning for 12U
- **5 Runs max per inning for 10U only.**
- Ties stand after scheduled full innings or time limit
- Players must hustle in and out between innings
- Three warm up pitches between innings and for pitching changes (have catchers ready)
- Both coaches, and umpire, should agree and note exact start time of game
- 4 Inning games cannot start a new inning after 1 hour (Saturday Only)
- Bottom of the 4th only played if you are home team and losing (just like a standard game)

To advance to Sunday's games:

- Total Points – (Win=2pts, Tie=1pt, Loss=0pt)
- Head to Head
- Total runs allowed
- Coin toss
- If 4 Pools then top team in each Pool advances
- If 3 Pools then a Wild Card Team advances
- Wild Card Team (from 2nd place team in each pool) – Total points, Total runs allowed, Coin Toss
- Best Record v 4th Best Record or Wild Card
- 2nd Best Record v 3rd Best Record
- All Sunday games will be full 4 inning games, with no time limit.

If you are returning for Sunday's finals, you need to be at the Fireman's Fields and ready by 9:30am for the opening ceremony.

- Winners play for Championship game; losers play consolation
- Higher seed will be home team.
- Concession stand will be open Saturday and Sunday.
- Please confine any team grilling to park pavilion areas and not near host concession stand.
