#### EHBEA Services to the Community 2026 Application Form

EHBEA Services to the Community award recognises the extensive amount of work our members do on mentorship, public outreach, teaching and training, ethical research practice, research integrity and science communication; in other words, on work that does not directly advance their own research agendas but adds value to the community of evolutionary behavioural science scholars. The prize is free registration and travel to the annual EHBEA conference.

As a society, we not only want to reward research excellence in terms of 'traditional' markers of publications, funding and network, but consider those working for excellence in other domains – often without reward – to improve the evolutionary human sciences. This may be (and is not limited to) working on the societal impact of evolutionary research, communicating evolutionary work to groups we do not normally reach, or mentoring or training the future generation in ethical, rigorous and robust methodological approaches.

If a colleague has come to mind reading this – nominate them now! Any active member of EHBEA can nominate any other member of the society. There is no further restriction on who can be nominated.

Nomination procedure: when nominating a member please provide the following:

- 1. A nomination form, that includes a short paragraph (around 250 words) about their work on any of the service domains listed above.
- 2. Details of a second nominator (but they do not need to complete the form)
- 3. Any relevant links or supporting material detailing service work and/or impact beyond academia, if applicable. For instance, testimonials from colleagues and students, links to public engagement work or websites and blogs, or copies of reports sharing findings with participants are all welcome. Unlike academic work much of individuals service work is not widely documented making it difficult to the committee to refer to outside information when coming to a decision. The more information provided the better!
