Event Programs:

- Names of Student Performers
- Recognition of site and district staff involved in the event. This should include the Board of Trustees listed in their current roles, the Superintendent, the Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services, the Executive Director of Educational Services, the Director of Arts Education, as well as the Principal, and Assistant Principals for school site events.
- Inclusion of the AUHSD Arts logo.
- Dates and locations of upcoming district-wide arts events.
- *Optional:* Relevant advocacy messages, such as benefits of student participation in the arts, where to get information about the arts programs at that school site, highlighting achievements of the students and the program, etc.
