



My Cambridge Application Guide for 2025/2026 Entry

What is the My Cambridge Application?

The purpose of the My Cambridge Application is to ensure that Cambridge has complete and consistent information about all applicants. It also enables Cambridge to collect information that's not part of the UCAS application but is helpful when assessing applications, such as the topics you've covered as part of your Singapore A Levels (which helps the interviewers decide which questions to ask).

Shortly after submitting your UCAS application, you'll be emailed and asked to complete My Cambridge Application. To make a valid application to the University of Cambridge, you must submit your My Cambridge Application by the deadline set. The deadline will be **22 October 2025 (18.00 UK time)**. If you're in any doubt about the deadline, please contact applicationhelp@ug.admin.cam.ac.uk as soon as possible to check.

** The onus is on the student to check the most updated information on the Cambridge website. ECG will not be responsible for the discrepancy on this guide as the information is continuously changing.*

Your application won't be complete unless you submit your transcript **on My Cambridge Application** [NOTE: Inclusion of other internal assessments such as Block Tests and Prelims will be at your discretion. Do remember that your file size must not exceed 5MB.]
