

# Add It Up within 10

## Materials:

- Two different colored counters (10 each color)
- One six sided die
- Playing chip (such as a penny, pebble, or paperclip)

## Directions

1. Player A rolls the die.
2. Player A chooses the move they want to play from the gray box at the bottom of the game board, and places the playing chip in that gray box.
3. Player A covers a corresponding square on the game board with the colored counter.
4. Player B takes a turn.
5. The object is to get four square in a row (across, up and down, or diagonal).
