Pre-Nursing Options at EvCC

Here is a comparison of prerequisites for getting an Associate Degree of Nursing (ADN) from EvCC vs. getting a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) from a 4-year school like UW-Bothell. It is a distillation of the <u>ADN PDF</u> and the <u>BSN PDF</u>, putting the respective requirements side by side so that they may be compared more easily.
