Scholarship Application Criteria

- (1) \$500 award for a Machining student and**
- (1) \$500 award for either Machining or Automotive**

These scholarships are for students participating in Delta-Schoolcraft CTE Machining and Automotive Programs. Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded in mid April so local schools can recognize the student at their award ceremonies.

The Scholarships will be based upon the following criteria:

- Student must be a graduating senior.

- Must plan to use the scholarship for the upcoming fall semester only.
- Must complete a scholarship application and personal statement essay.

- Attendance in their Career-Technical Education Program
- Attitude
- School and Community Activities
- Work Experience
- Essay
