Kylie Jenner and Kate Upton fought to see who was the top Stable Leader and Miley Cyrus went in hell bound to destroy hated rival Kristen Bell. No onto our interviews. All of the Barbies took pictures after the Gala and will share them with their fans. They looked amazing.

Featherweights



Erin: Congratulations on your big winm Jules. After an opening loss to Nina Dobrev, you’ve been unbeatable and fought your way to a title fight. What did Catrinel Menghia bring that worried you the most?

Julianne: Her reach. She has 6” on me but she also has long arms and legs. I think she had like a 10” reach advantage.

Erin: That made little difference as you dominated the unbeaten Champ in all aspects of the fight. Where did you feel you had an advantage?

Julianne: Like I said, she’s long so we felt if we could get her in close it would even up the odds. I was able to go to the body and it took some of the sting out of her strikes.

Erin: Now I’ve heard a rumor that you will be moving to the Welterweight division. Would you be willing to give up your title?

Julianne: Kylie requested the move last month. I normally walk around at 123lbs so I have to drop weight for each fight.

Erin: Will you be willing to take on Belen Rodriguez for the belt?

Julianne: I’m not clear on the rules in the UCC but I may have to fight a few matches before I can challenge for the Welterweight title. You’re also assuming that Shailene isn’t going to win.

Erin: If you remain a Featherweight, you’ll defend your title against Choi soo-young. What will you do to stop her as she has caused more damage than any fighter in any division in the entire UCC?

Julianne: Once Choi get going there’s no stopping her. She has completely dominated some of the best Featherweights. We are working on a strategy but she just dominated one of the best grapplers using her clinch. Something she’s never shown before so she obviously is a quick learner. We’ll have to cover all bases as she looks like she can win many ways.



Erin: Livvy, you were very nervous going into the cage against your teammate Lucy Hale. Is that because your good friends?

Olivia: Not really. Of course were tight but I was nervous because Lucy is undefeated and a tremendous fighter.

Erin: Did you two train separately?

Olivia: Normally we help each other out. I’ll pretend I’m her opponent and she’ll do the same. I missed training with her. She’s such a kook.

Erin: You got the better of her tonight. Tell us about the fight.

Olivia: Sure. The fight started out very close. I landed some strikes while Lucy did some damage on the ground.

Erin: You took over and from the 2nd on Lucy was in big trouble. When do you feel that the fight turned around?

Olivia: I just wore her down in the clinch. She did good at first pushing me away and I was getting frustrated but I kept with it.

Erin: You’re 5-0 and will fight Gavintra Photijak in Germany. Any thoughts?

Olivia: Gam’s been tearing it up lately.

Erin: Gam? What’s a Gam?

Olivia: Gavintra is known as “Gam” in the UCC. Either way she’s one of the elite Featherweights and I’ll have a hard fight.



Erin: Unlike Olivia, you seemed very confident. Did you feel that you were going to win?

Lucy: I always go into the cage feeling that I’m the better fighter. If I didn’t then I have no business in the UCC

Erin: Do you think that it comes off wrong by not showing your opponent respect?

Lucy: I’m not the least bit arrogant but I’m confident. If you show weakness this league will eat you up and spit you out.

Erin: You get Jennie from Black Pink at the next event. What do you know about her?

Lucy: All I know is what I saw and that was her beating the snot out of Jaclyn Swedberg from the Centerfold Angels. I believe Jaclyn was undefeated and Jennie made her look bad, really bad. She tied her up and just kept pounding on her. I’ll work on my clinch and be ready.



Erin: Nina, what can you tell us about Alpha Angel Hitomi Taneka?

Nina: Besides her enormous tits?

Erin: That's obvious. What can you tell us about your match?

Nina: Hitomi loves to wrestle and prefers to get on top and smother you with her, ummm, her enormous assets.

Erin: What did you do to keep her off you and stay on your feet?

Nina: I used my striking to keep her off balance and went to the body trying to wear her down.

Erin: Well you kind of turned the tables but we'll get to that in a bit.

Nina: We can get to that right now. She did manage to take me down but I had an answer and worked in a little ground strikes then submitted her.

Erin: You had her beat, was a Facesit really necessary

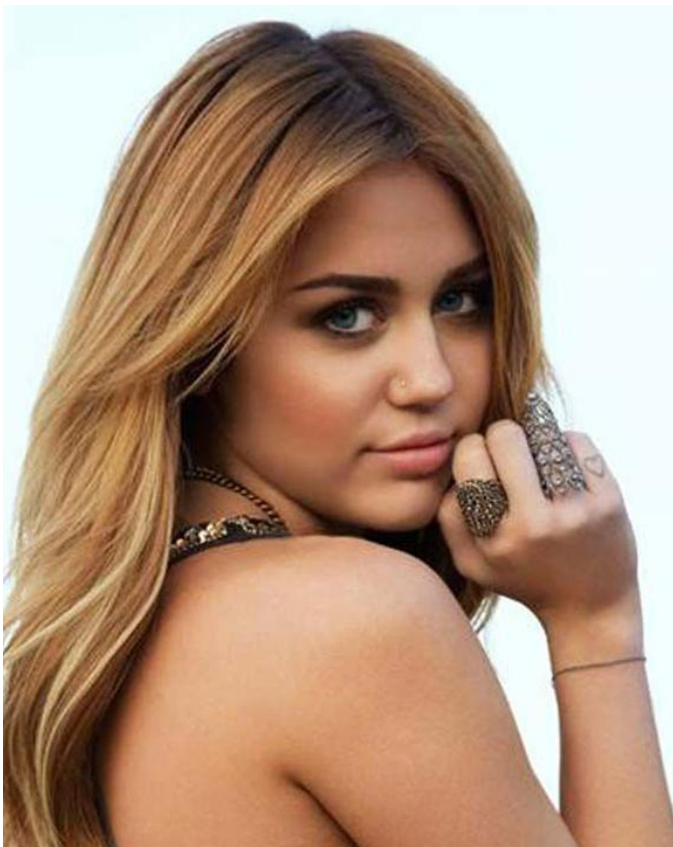
Nina: Actually, I was sitting on her chest and she bridged up. Unfortunately I slide on her face. It wasn't intentional.

Erin: You'll be fighting Maissie Williams in Germany. How will you prepare for her?

Nina: Lots of cardio. Maissie never gives up. I think she's logged over 35 rounds so far. She just likes to fight.



Erin: Miley, You were very vocal taking to the UCC forum to taunt your opponent Kristen Bell. Do you and Kristen have a history?

Miley: Not really. She just looks like a fucking loser so I couldn't resist.

Erin: She dropped you with a vicious right hand and it looked like you were hurt. How close were you to blacking out?

Miley: Not even close. That was the only time she laid a glove on me.

Erin: You went after her hair a few of times. Did you see a weakness?

Miley: I gave her hair a good tug and she was on the verge of crying. She must be sensitive or something so I did it again.

Erin: You went back to the body and to be honest, Kristen looked like she didn't want any part of you. When did you know the fight was over?

Miley: After the 1st few exchanges. I could tell that she wasn't going to do much. She is a loser from the Aries you know. I'll admit that they're pretty viscous in catfights but you saw what I did to her in the cage.

Erin: You'll face Vixen Annasophia Robb in Germany. She's always a tough draw and it should be a good test? Will we see some taunts?

Miley: There's no doubt that she is talented but I'm sure I'll have something for her. Both on the forum and in the cage.



Erin: Vanessa, you initially drew Shraddha Das from Club Bad but ended up fighting Chrissie Chau from the Awesome Aries. Why were you so upset?

Vanessa: I had a really good camp and was ready for Shradda.

Erin: I agree it's not fair but Chrissie was in the same predicament.

Vanessa: You know, I hate being rushed and there's all this pressure fighting those bitches especially after what they did to Kendall. Ganging up on her is what cowards do.

Erin: You came out fast and took the fight to her. Did you feel that was your best strategy?

Vanessa: I'm not going to lie, Chrissie is a good fighter but I knew she was a different fighter when she's backing up.

Erin: You caught her clean and dropped her in the 1st minute. Did that change the fight?

Vanessa: She was OK but after I hit her in the ribs I could see she was on the verge of crying. When you have an opponent on the ropes you can't let up and let her back into the fight.

Erin: The fight got personal as you clawed her breasts, dropped an elbow across her chest and eventually gave her an atomic wedgie that left Chrissie with broken ribs,

Vanessa: OK, I feel bad about her ribs but this is a fight and she would have done the same to me if she got the chance.

Lightweights



Erin: Dove, how tough is it fighting a former teammate?

Erin: Did she pick up any new skills over at Strikeforce?

Dove: She’s gotten really good at takedowns. I think she was something like 6 for 6. It changed the fight as I wanted to keep it away from the mat.

Erin: Do you feel that was because you took over in the clinch?

Dove: Maybe so but she’s always liked to roll around on the ground.

Erin: You easily won the fight by out striking her 81 to 33 but were unable to put her away. Were you starting to get frustrated?

Dove: Not at all. Emma is an amazing talent and I knew it was going to take my best effort.

Erin: You’ll be in a similar situation in Germany when you’ll fight another former teammate Tiffany Fallon. Are you two still close?

Dove: Don’t get me wrong, Tiff and I were friends but we drifted apart after the UMMA folded. She’s really done well for her new team and I look forward to finally getting to face her in the cage.



Erin: Ashley, Internet Darling Courtney Miller has had early success in the UCC. Were you ready for her?

Ashley: She may have surprised her 1st opponents but I knew how good she was and I trained my ass off. Her striking is amazing.

Erin: What did you do to keep away from Courtney's quick hands?

Ashley: We knew that if I could get in close I’d be able to control her and keep her from getting into a groove. Once Courtney starts opening up and finding her range she is hard to stop.

Erin: I see that you have been working on some new skills. Do you care to elaborate on them?

Ashley: I’m sure it’s no secret now but Kylie has had most of us working on our submission skills. I’m new to it but it’s an amazing feeling when you lock in a submission. It’s spirit breaking when she can’t break free.

Erin: You attempted 6 before you finally trapped Courtney in a difficult triangle from mount. Was that a hard move to learn?

Ashley: It’s not easy getting your leg under an opponent from the top but once I got my leg around her neck I knew I had her.

Erin: Will we see more submission attempts against your next opponent Malika Sherewat?

Ashley: I doubt it because Malika is one of the better ground fighters and I’ll struggle to keep the fight standing.



Erin: Madison, Chelsie Aryn is a very strong ground fighter. What did you work on getting ready for her?

Madison: The key to success against Chelsie is to not let her take you down. I worked on my takedown defense and also did a lot of squats.

Erin: Why squats?

Madison: In case she takes me down and I needed to use my legs to keep her in my guard. It may not look hard but your legs start to burn. You do a bunch of squats and then wrap your legs around a training dummy and see how long you can squeeze.

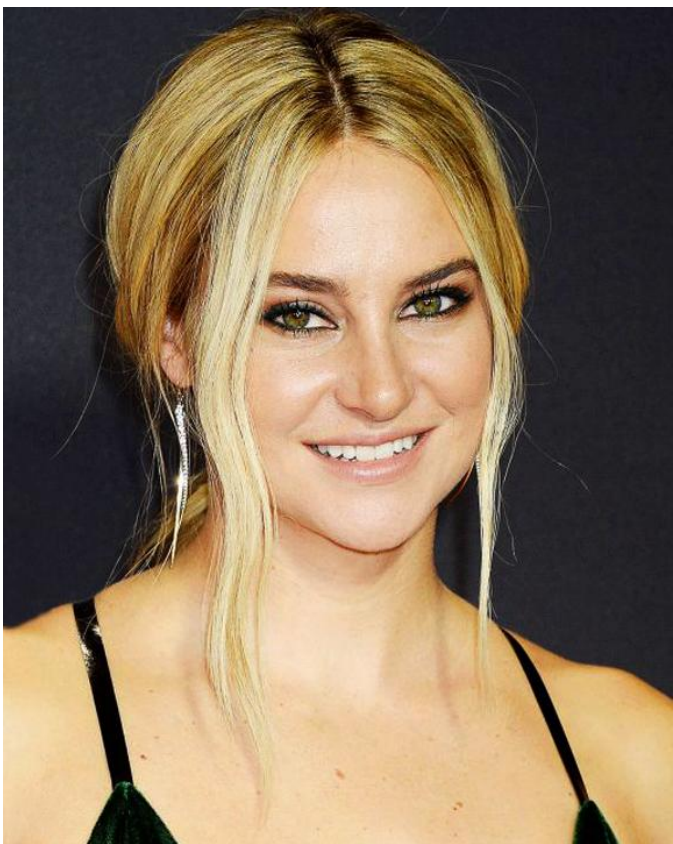
Erin: The fight was going Chelsie’s way and the 1st two rounds saw you on the mat with her on top. What did you do between rounds?

Madison: My corner was brutally honest and said if I didn’t start throwing down I was going to get pounded into oblivion.

Erin: You responded with a brilliant flurry that stopped Chelsie but will we see some submissions from you against Peyton List in Germany?

Madison: All I know is that Peyton has a long reach and can hit hard and has yet to be submitted.

Welterweights



Erin: Shailene, you've had some early success but that means that the competition is going to be hard. Both you and Lily James are 7-1 with the winner getting a shot at the title. How much pressure were you under?

Shailene: There's not a lot of room for error when you fight Lily. Her striking is accurate and she puts a lot of power behind them. I knew that to beat her I would have to beat her to the punch.

Erin: You came out fast and had Lilly in trouble and on her heels. When did you feel that the fight was going your way?

Shailene: By the end of the 1st I could tell that she was slowing down and tried to keep her distance.

Erin: When you see that happen does that make you fight harder?

Shailene: That depends but if you feel your opponent trying to get away and wants no part of you then you try and finish her off.

Erin: Are you excited to get a title shot against Belen Rodriguez?

Shailene: Excited and nervous. Belen is probably the best pound for pound fighter in the UCC..She's not only the best striker but she has amazing takedown defense and is probably the best grappler.

Erin: Will you try some submissions?

Shailene: Of course but I'll be trying everything to beat her and it's going to take my best effort.



Erin: Selena, you've mentioned many times that your idol has always been Britney Spears. Was it difficult facing her?

Selena: Not only is she my favorite musician, she is my favorite fighter and the reason I got into cage fighting. I was so nervous. She's the best.

Erin: Britney came out and got your attention by kicking you in the leg 10 seconds into the fight. You looked to be in a great deal of pain.

Selena: She got me good and my eyes were cloudy and I was limping around after that. She has solid legs from all of her dancing..

Erin: You fought through the pain and clinched up and took it to Britney until she rocked you with a kick below your breasts.

Selena: Every time I'd start taking over she landed a kick that hurt me.

Erin: It ended up being a great back and forth battle until the end of the 1st. Tell us what happened.

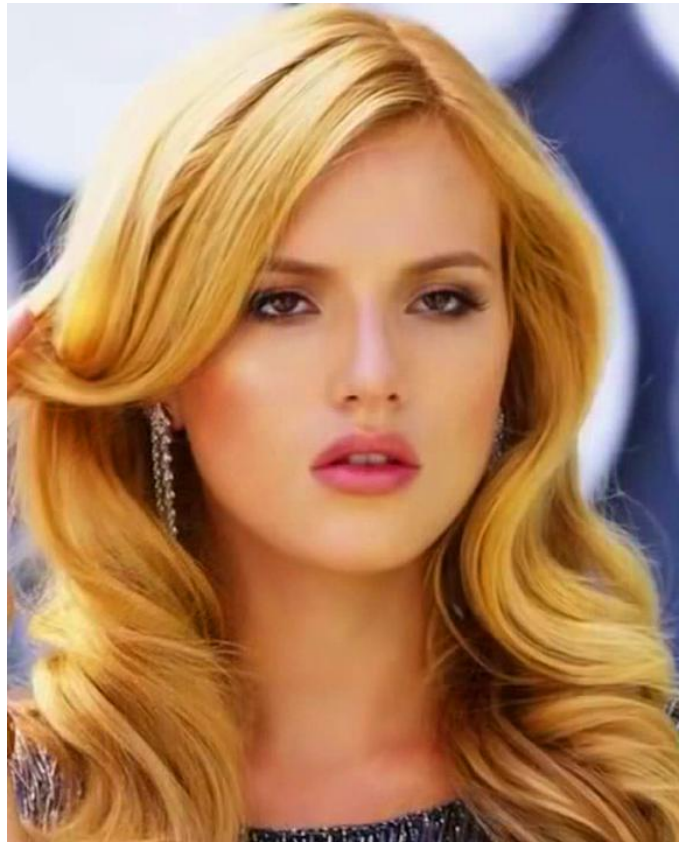
Selena: I was so worried about being kicked again that I never saw her come at me and before I knew what happened she laid me out with a flurry of punches.

Bella: Absolutely, it's hard watching your teammates have all the fun.

Erin: Is fighting a winless fighter like Roxanne Pattett difficult?

Bella: No doubt, we were both desperate and were willing to do whatever it took to get a win. We didn't hold anything back.

Erin: Why did you look so nervous before the fight?

Bella: Roxanne's last two wins were from a Breast Smother and a Breast Claw. While I don't mind having a nice set of boobs in my face having someone dig in their talons can cause serious damage. I have my selfies to worry about and who wants to see scratched boobs

Jennifer: For one, she in amazing shape and she also has a nasty right hand. She had 3 KO's and a win by injury.

Erin: You looked amazing and were able to take her down and control her on the mat, Were you surprised that you also dominated the striking?

Jennifer: I spent most of my camp working on my striking. Ever since Evangeline Lilly almost broke my ribs I've been a better striker.

Erin: When did you feel the fight was going your way?

Jennifer: The 2nd time I took her down she let out a groan and after that I could tell I had her.

Erin: You cracked the top 50 in the overall standings and are currently the 12th ranked Middleweight. Who do you see as your biggest stumbling block on your way to the title?

Jennifer: Sharon Stone. What she did to Malin Ackerman is just sick.

Erin: You're talking about the standing body scissors I take it?

Jennifer: I think poor Malin is having nightmares about that. Sharon was crushing the shit out of her. Malin never saw it coming and never had a chance of breaking free. That was a nasty hold.



Erin: Kendall, you didn't have many kind words for you opponent Lindsay Lohan before the fight. Have you two had previous run ins?

Kendall: She looks strong, very strong. I'll have to do some extra strength and conditioning in camp. I wouldn't want her to bully me around the cage.



Erin: Zendaya, Congratulations on winning Kylie;s Core Challenge. You were genuinely surprised when Kylie announced your name.

Zendaya: Fortunately Alexandra Paul picked me. I know she had a hard decision seeing how all of the Barbies are in incredible shape. I got to show my abs off and get a lot of ribbing from the girls but it's all fun.

Erin: You unfortunately drew Elizabeth Hurley, who has been on a tear and won 4 out of her last 5. What did she do to turn it around?

Zendaya: If Tough Liz didn't have to fight her rivals over at Pye's, she would be undefeated. After a couple of close losses, she's been as good as any fighter in the league and now she's not only an elite striker but she has developed into a crafty submission fighter.

Erin: How close was she to submitting you when she sat on your face?

Zendaya: She should be called "Nasty Liz". I'm glad I was able to keep my composure. I didn't see that coming but was able to bridge out of it.

Erin: You dominated the fight beating her around the cage but ended the match with a spectacular submission. Was this planned or did you take advantage of the situation?

Zendaya: As everyone knows by now, the Barbies have been working on their submissions. My trainers taught me how to apply a Leg Spread but they never thought I'd never be able to get Liz to tap with her incredibly muscular legs . Once I locked it in and started pulling her legs apart she lost focus and tapped.



Erin: Welcome Zara, how has it been going so far?

Zara: I'm starting to feel comfortable. At first it was like panic city.

Erin: Anne Hathaway has been at this a long time. Did her experience trouble you?

Heavyweights



Erin: Taylor, I'm going to get right to it. You haven't lost 3 fights in a row since early in 2016. What will you do to turn it around?

Taylor: Fighting Eugenie Bouchard wasn't the answer. She is incredible as are all of her teammates. I thought I was in a good position to win but she proved to be too much in the later rounds.

Erin: You had the odds against you seeing that you came in with a 2 fight losing streak and Eugenie had won all 4 of her fights by injury. Momentum is the key to success in the UCC.

Taylor: She's a beast and once she gets you in a clinch it takes a lot of energy to break free.

Erin: In the end the strikes were even at 60 each but Eugenie caused more damage. Were you feeling confident before the decision was announced?

Taylor: I felt that I did enough to win and the fight could have gone either. I was disappointed with the loss but I'll move on.

Erin: You'll be fighting Death by Bikini Bojana Krsmanovic at Oktoberfest. What will you do to get a much needed win?

Taylor: Hopefully get a quick knockout. It won't be easy against Bo.



Erin: Kylie, you've always shown a ton of respect towards Kate Upton. Are you two friends?

Kylie: Nom I've never met Kate but I love how she carries herself about. She's a real class act. A real role model.

Erin: Do you feel that Kate's nerves were getting to her?

Kylie: I seriously doubt it. Kate's a pro and there's no reason for that.

Erin: Kate came out and almost ended the fight in the 1st 10 seconds. How close was that head kick?

Kylie: Close, really close. Kate is known for her awesome breasts but all of the fighters in the UCC will tell you that her legs are her best asset. That near miss put me on alert.

Erin: You dominate the action by using you clinch but Kate managed to hang on until the 3rd. Could you tell that Kate was wearing down?

Kylie: I felt I won rounds 1 and 2 and Kate was slowing down. When your opponent is struggling you have to go in for the kill. I grabbed her hair and she wasn't fighting back so Eva Habermann called the fight.

Erin: You will fight Angel Valerie van der Graaf in Germany. Thoughts?

Kylie: It will be a good fight but I should be able to take her.



Erin: Welcome, Katy. Adrienne Palicki started 5-0 but has struggled lately. Did you feel confident facing her?

Katy: Not at all. Adrienne is amazing and if you look at her losses, they're against title holder Gabrielle Reece and her 6-1 teammate Blanka Vlasic. They're a scary bunch of girls.

Erin: It ended up being a one-sided crush match with you being able to control the fight in the clinch and completely pummel her on the ground. What gave you an advantage over Adrienne?

Katy: I was able to land some early head shots and scrambled her brains. Her eyes were rolling all around. She never fully recovered.

Erin: You tried to end the fight with a stomach claw. Just how effective is that seeing that few fights have ended that way?

Katy: I don't see anyone tapping to a stomach claw seeing that it would take incredible hand strength but I can tell you they hurt like a bitch.

Erin: Is that considered a submission then?

Katy: I suppose if someone tapped out then it would be.

Erin: Why didn't you go for a submission when you had Adrienne out on her feet?

Katy: I'm not going to go for a submission just to do it. When you get the chance to put a beatdown on someone as good as Adrienne, you do it.

Erin: You get another shot at Queen of the Cage Jasmina Marazite. Will you be better prepared this time?

Katy: I hope so. It only took her 4 punches to open me up and she ended the fight in under 1 minute. She's a terror in the cage and I hope I'll be able to stay clear of her power. Her legs are like tree trunks.



Erin: Welcome, Hailee. It's no secret that you've struggled so far in the UCC. Did you feel you had to switch up your training tactics when you found out you'd be fighting Karate Diva Magan Gale?

Hailee: The Heavyweight division is insanely stacked with talent. There are some scary fighters who can really mess you up. Megan Gale isd one of them.

Erin: Both of you were feeling the pressure. Megan was already sweating and you were nervously shifting back and forth.

Hailee: Pressure? Both of us had 2 fight losing streaks and this fight could have lasting effects. I knew I couldn't lose.

Erin: Megan came out and put a beatdown on you punishing you in the clinch, landing nasty legs kicks and swarming all over you on the ground. How badly were you hurt?

Hailee: I'm not going to lie, She hit me so hard in the gut that it took most of the round to catch my breath. She worked over my thighs and had my limping. Once I made it to the bell I finally got a chance to regroup. My corner did a wonderful job of getting me ready.

Erin: She came right at you but you were able to turn the fight around and give her some payback. What did you do differently?

Hailee: She probably thought she had me and was about to get a win. She looked shocked when I was able to fight back.

Erin: As bad as the 1st went for you, the 2nd was worse for Megan and by the end of the round you had her spilling a lot of blood. Did you feel you were in control when the 3rd started?

Hailee: Megan did a good job of tying me up and keeping me close. I did some damage in the 3rd but let her recover.

Erin: Megan's corner couldn't stop the bleeding and the ref was keeping a close eye on her. Did you feel the fight should have been stopped earlier?

Hailee: You hope so but Megan was fighting back. She wasn't hitting me but she was still throwing punches.

Erin: It finally took a hair pull for ref to stop the beating. You'll fight Megan's teammate Dafne Shippers in Germany. Do you expect the same sort of fight from Dafne?

Hailee: All I know is that Dafne will be the hometown favorite. I'm sure she'll want to come out and win. She easily beat Megan in Canada. She just threw her to the ground and pounded her lights out. I'll be working on my takedown defense for sure.

Erin: That will do it for Kangaroo Court. We'll see everyone in Germany where the Barbies will look for another stellar performance.
