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Description of the Task:

You will complete an in-class Task based upon your formative (class) work. The Task will have three parts which demonstrates your knowledge and understanding of the Life and Times of Jesus, as well as your scripture analysis and response writing skills. You will have 50 minutes to complete the task under examination conditions.

2. Part 2: The Sick in Jesus' Time (10 marks)
3. Part 3: The Life and Times of Jesus (5 marks)

You will have 50 minutes (45 minutes working time + 5 minutes reading time) to complete the task under examination conditions. No notes or other research material is to be used.
