Purpose and Scope

The purpose of the policy is to outline the circumstances under which access to or presence on the Kansas City Art Institute property may be revoked or restricted and the procedures for doing so.

The policy applies to KCAI students, faculty, staff, and visitors.

Policy Details

While the Kansas City Art Institute is a private institution of higher education, the campus is open to the general public. However, the college has the ability to determine the expectations and parameters for an individual's presence on college property. The college retains the right to restrict access to college property due to safety considerations relating to its students, faculty, staff and visitors and may issue a No Trespass Notice to individuals when appropriate.

Procedure

When it is determined that an individual presents a threat or disturbance to campus, the college may issue a No Trespass Notice restricting that person from any property owned or controlled by the college for a period of time to be determined on a case-by-case basis. Failure to comply with the Notice could result in arrest, criminal sanctions and civil penalties without further warning if the individual refuses to leave or returns while the Notice is in effect.

Notice may be given verbally and/or in writing. Members of the Security department, as well as Vice Presidents and Associate Vice Presidents may give notice. Notice may only be revoked by these individuals.
