No experience necessary.

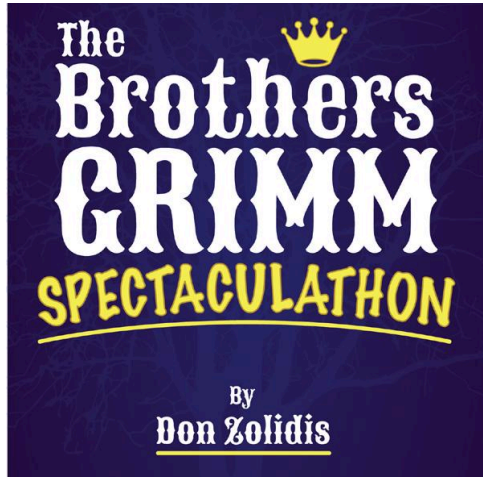
If you would like to participate, you will need to be available for all the sessions (unless pre-approved by me) and have access to a hands-free device in a quiet space.
