The time has come for our Glendale seniors to walk across the stage to celebrate their hard work. As your seniors' high school journey slowly comes to an end and your future begins to take shape, we are thankful that we have had the opportunity and your trust to guide and develop their vision beyond Glendale High School.

With less than a quarter left in their senior year, it is also a time that can become confusing, stressful, and exciting. Our goal is to provide proper planning and communication to the families of GHS to ensure we alleviate any anxieties within this exciting time for your student and family. Our graduation ceremony is scheduled for <u>Saturday</u>, <u>May 18</u>, <u>2024 at 11:30 a.m.</u> at the <u>Great Southern Bank Arena</u>. Students should arrive no later 10:30 a.m. and enter Hammons Student Center through the southeast corner (the walkway between Hammons and Great Southern Arena). Once checked in, students will not be allowed to leave until the conclusion of the ceremony. Parking is available in various lots at Missouri State. <u>Spectators may enter Great Southern Bank Arena through the southwest, northwest, or southeast doors.</u> At the conclusion of the ceremony, students will be escorted out of the arena and will receive their diploma. <u>Parents and guardians may meet their student on the northeast exterior corner of Great Southern Bank Arena</u>.

While graduation is certainly a time for celebration, the ceremony itself should remain dignified. Glendale has a long tradition of excellent attendance, honor, and respect for the graduation ceremony and families. We respectfully request that our students wear slacks, dress shirt, tie, dress shoes and socks OR a dress and dress shoes. Students are not to wear athletic shoes or jeans. No other accessories can be added to the Glendale cap and gown. Purses, cameras, and cell phones should not be brought. Students not in compliance may not be allowed to walk in the ceremony. Please note that a photographer will be present to take pictures of all students as they receive their diploma cover.

The Springfield Public School District requires that students meet all graduation requirements in order to participate in graduation. An alternate graduation ceremony will be conducted at the end of summer school students who complete the graduation requirements during the semester.
