Spring 2022 Dual Enrollment – Louisiana Tech University

To be eligible to take a course for spring dual enrollment, students must earn a 'B' or higher in that course, fall 2021. Tuition for one English, math, science, or social studies course may be covered on a first come, first served basis until funds are depleted. It is to your advantage to apply early. Additional fees (course packet and application fee) must be paid by the student.

Courses Available (high school course name and college course name)

- English IV E with Ms. Williams or Mrs. Waxham (ENGL 101: Freshman Composition I, ENGL 102 Freshman Composition II)
- English IV AP, and AP/GT (ENGL 101: Freshman Composition I, ENGL 102 Freshman Composition II, ENGL 211 Introduction to British Literature, Romantic Era To The Present)
- AP European History (HIST 102: World History Since 1500)
- AP US History (HIST 202: History of the US: 1877 Present)

Minimum Criteria for Enrollment

- Student must be on track for completing the TOPS University Curriculum
- Student must have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale
- ACT composite score of at least 19 and ACT English score of at least 18 and ACT Math score of 19;
 print a copy of the score report to turn in with your application. See Mrs. Byrd or Mrs. Lacy if you do not meet either the English or Math sub-score criteria to determine if you are eligible.

How To Apply

Students new to Louisiana Tech dual enrollment this school year:

- Begin now online at https://secure.latech.edu/admissions/dualenrapplynow/; (you will have to enter your e-mail address to complete registration. You will receive a password from Louisiana Tech. You may have to check your junk mail folder to find this e-mail)
- Complete, submit and print the online application; there should be 4 pages
- After printing the application:
 - o student and parent must sign pages 2 and 4 where indicated;
 - o after reviewing the students ACT score report to verify test score eligibility, the dual enrollment teacher must initial page 3 beside the course the student will take; several courses will be listed on the application but only the courses listed above are available at Byrd with La Tech
 - o Turn in the following to Mrs. Byrd or Mrs. Lacy no later than Friday, January 8, 2022:
 - ✔ Paper application (4 pages) with required signatures and initials
 - ✓ An official copy of the ACT score report
 - ✓ Payment \$20 application fee (<u>paid once per school year</u>) and tuition, \$150 per course, if you are required to pay; check or money order (*NO CASH*) made out to La Tech University; the application fee and tuition can be submitted together in one check; contact Mrs. Byrd or Mrs. Lacy if you are unsure about the amount to pay
 - <u>✓ English 101 and 102 students only</u> \$30 course packet fee; cash, check or money order made out to C E Byrd or online at payforit.net (<u>paid once per school year</u>)

Students who completed a fall dual enrollment course this school year:

- You will not complete the online application
- Complete the one page 'Louisiana Tech Spring 2022 DE Add Course' form and turn it in to Mrs. Byrd or Mrs. Lacy by the due date. Only one form is needed per student.
- Turn in the following to your counselor no later than Friday, January 8, 2022:
 - ✓ One page 'Louisiana Tech Spring 2022 DE add course' form
 - ✓ A copy of the ACT score report
 - Payment \$150 per course if you are required to pay; check or money order (NO CASH) made out to La Tech University; contact Mrs. Byrd or Mrs. Lacy if you are unsure about the amount to pay
 - <u>✓ English 101 and 102 students only</u> if this is your first dual enrollment English class this school year, you must pay the \$30 course packet fee; cash, check or money order made out to C E Byrd or online at payforit.net
