Tu B'Shevat/Tu BiSh'vat, the Jewish holiday that celebrates the birthday of the trees, occurs on the 15th of the Hebrew month of Shevat, sometime in late January or early February. Originally an agricultural festival, the main customs of this holiday are to taste some of the fruits and nuts of Israel and to plant trees. Tu B'Shevat is a time to give gratitude to God for all the fruits of the earth and everything that he gives us.
