This semester, there are three **State testing dates** of which we want to make you aware:

Wednesday, March 13 - Illinois Science Assessment (**ISA**)

- ALL JUNIORS are **required** to take the ISA on March 13. This State exam assesses students in a variety of Science areas. Juniors will finish at approximately 10:45am. Busing to and from school will be provided.
- On March 13, FRESHMEN, SOPHOMORES, and SENIORS will NOT have regularly scheduled classes. We will be inviting students **in need of academic support** to school to work with our Faculty from 7:25-10:45am. Busing will be provided to and from school.

Wednesday, April 10 - School-Day **SAT** with Essay

- ALL JUNIORS will be taking the SAT with Essay on this day. **The School-Day SAT is a graduation requirement.**
- FRESHMEN, SOPHOMORES and SENIORS have No School on this day.

Thursday, April 11 - **PSAT**

- FRESHMEN and SOPHOMORES will be taking the PSAT
- JUNIORS and SENIORS have No School on this day.

Some students with accommodations will follow a different schedule. This will be communicated by case managers.
