Practice the formation of relief art using paper/gypsum as a medium (non-figurative form) 4. Working on ornamental forms using cement as a medium to create relief works of art in collaboration 5. Finishing the relief results using coloring techniques  <b>Course content</b>  1) Week 1-2 : Explains the Course Module and course contract of Relief, and introduces some tools and materials used for making relief art 2) Week 3-4-5 : Practice the design of (figures or non-figures) and creating reliefs using clay as a medium 3) Week 6-7-9 : Practice the design and creating reliefs using gypsum plaster or paper as medium 4) Week 8 : Midterm Test – material : non-figures relief design 5) Week :10-11-12-13 : Work on ornament with cement as medium (added with a structure on the base of the relief) in collaborative relief artwork 6) Week 14-15 : Finishing the relief artwork with coloring technique 7) Week 16 : UAS : Relief art design with story as an object				



2020, Article 19). Hence, since the Relief course is 3 credits, the student workload =  $3 \text{ credits} \times 170 \text{ minutes} \times 14 \text{ meetings} / 60 \text{ minutes} = 119 \text{ hours}$ .

3. For contact hours or face-to-face meetings of Relief course (3 credits), the calculation is  $(3 \text{ credits} \times 50 \text{ minutes} \times 14 \text{ meetings}) / 60 \text{ minutes} = 35 \text{ hours}$ . (there is no face-to-face meeting for the time being, due to covid-19 pandemic).
4. For independent study or independent learning in Relief (3 credits), the calculation is  $(3 \text{ credits} \times 60 \text{ minutes} \times 14 \text{ meetings}) / 60 \text{ minutes} = 42 \text{ hours}$ .
