The The 7 Remarkable Traits of a Local Church Subtopic: Paul Thanks God For the Church Col. 1:3-8

- Not all churches are made equal (v.3).
- In this section, Paul thank God for seven things that he saw in the church. These are the seven marks of a true believer in Christ.
- How can you tell a tree?
- 1. <u>Faith in Christ Jesus</u>. Verse *4 Because we have heard of your faith in Christ Jesus*

Eph 2:8-9, For by grace are ye saved through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of Christ, not of works, lest any many should boast.

2. **Love** for God's People. Verse 4, and of the love you have for all God's people—

Matt. 18:6 "If anyone causes one of these little ones—those who believe in me—to stumble, it would be better for them to have a large millstone hung around their neck and to be drowned in the depths of the sea."

A person growing in Christ protects and loves new believers.

- 3. <u>Hope</u> for the future. Verse 5 the faith and love that spring from the hope stored up for you in heaven and
 - a. A true believer loves the coming of Christ.
 - b. He may live his life today the way he will be like in the future.

c. Hope in the future affects us today.

Romans 5:2-5, 2 ...we boast in the hope of the glory of God. 3 Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; 4 perseverance, character; and character, hope. 5 And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts...

- 4. <u>Hear</u> the gospel. Verse 5, about which you have already heard in the true message of the gospel 6 that has come to you.
 - 1 Cor. 15:2 By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain. 3 For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance[a]: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,
- 5. <u>Live</u> the Gospel. Verse 5, In the same way, the gospel is bearing fruit and growing throughout the world—just as it has been doing among you since the day you heard it

Is your life bringing others to Jesus Christ?

- 6. **Study** God. Verse 6, and truly understood God's grace.
 - a. A true believer studies the word.
 - b. It is grace that saves us (Eph 2:8-9), It is grace that makes us move and live forward, 2 Cor.

12:9 "But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness" (2 Corinthians 12:9).

- 7. <u>Learn</u> from a teacher/mentor / from one another. Verse 7, You learned it from Epaphras, our dear fellow servant,[c] who is a faithful minister of Christ on our[d] behalf, 8 and who also told us of your love in the Spirit.
 - a. Why Epaphras? Because he is a faithful minister of Christ... who will teach you how to love in the Spirit. When we are looking for those who lead God's flock... when you are looking for teachers of the word and leaders of small groups, look for two things...among others...
