The Education Foundation of Canyon ISD has long been committed to identifying and incentivizing such leadership skills, which not only encourage excellence and awareness in our students today, but as they move forward on their educational paths.

General Information

- Student Leadership Grants are available for student-led projects/programs at *any CISD campus in any grade level*. Existing student organizations are encouraged to apply, but applicants are not required to be affiliated with a standing group.
- All proposed projects/programs must be compliant with CISD policy and guidelines for safety, security, expenditure of funds, fund-raising, etc.
- At this time, there is no predetermined number of Student Leadership Grants to be awarded for the current school year.
- Grant requests should be limited to approximately \$200. Smaller grants are most welcome and encouraged!
- Student Leadership Grant Applications may be submitted at any time during the school year. The completed application should be submitted to Kelly Norman, Executive Director of the Education Foundation, at the District Support Center.
- Student Leadership Grant Applications will be considered by the Education Foundation Board of Directors at monthly general meetings. Upon selection for approval, the Foundation will expedite the award of funds as much as possible.
