Chromebook Summer Care Guide

Families of CUSD Students returning in the fall:

In the unlikely case of the 21/22 school year being anything besides a full return to regular school hours, most students will keep their assigned chromebooks with them over the summer. In order to make sure that they remain in working order over the summer and will be ready for the coming school year, please follow these guidelines in addition to the terms of our existing [Student/Parent Chromebook Agreement](#).

- Chromebooks should be kept in a temperature controlled environment, and away from sources of humidity. A backpack is fine if the Chromebook will not be used.
- Store the Chromebook in a place where it will not be stepped on or suffer any other harm. Keep it away from sources of water and direct sunlight.
- Chromebooks do not need to be plugged in or kept charged if they are not being used for extended periods of time. Chargers should be unplugged as well if not being used. Have them ready for the first day/week of school though!
- Chromebooks can be cleaned with a damp cloth or alcohol cleaning wipes. Never expose a device to a direct spray of any solution.
- In the extremely unlikely event that a Chromebook shows signs of swelling in the battery area- located under the trackpad- it should be placed in a safe space as it could be a fire hazard. Contact your school or the district office to have it picked up.
- It is currently unknown whether or not chromebooks will be stored in Classroom technology carts after our return to school, and it will likely depend on your school and teacher. Be prepared for them to have a spot in children's backpacks.
