Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Hearts of Elegance Bundle (164916)
- **Card Stock** – Basic White (159276), Basic White Thick (159229), Real Red (102482), Gold Foil (132622)
- **Stamp Pads** – Real Red (147084)
- **Misc.** – Adhesive-backed Heart Sequins (164920), Gold Twisted Thread (164603), Stylish Shapes Dies (159183), Marbled Elegance Designer Series Paper (164919)

Measurements:

- Thick Basic White: (2) 5 ½" X 8 ½" score at 4 ¼"
- Real Red: (2) 4" X 5 ¼"
- Marbled Elegance Designer Series Paper: 4" X 5 ¼"
- Basic White scrap for Banner Die
- Gold Foil scrap for heart die cut

Instructions:

1. Fold your card bases in half.
2. Score the Marbled Elegance Designer Series Paper at 2 5/8" across the 5 ¼" side.
3. Place the Heart die onto the Marbled Elegance paper with the center of the heart die lined up on the score line and run it through your Cut & Emboss Machine.
4. Place the die cut heart onto your trimmer and cut down the score line, do this for both the heart and the Marbled Elegance paper piece.
5. Attach ½ of the Marbled Elegance paper piece to the Real Red cardstock making sure to line up the side, top and bottom flush. (1/2 on the right-hand side and the other ½ on the left-hand side of the second piece of Real Red cardstock.)
6. Attach ½ of the heart die cut to the other side, creating the split negative. You will make two cards using each ½ of the heart (1/2 on the right-hand side and the other ½ on the left-hand side of the second piece of Real Red cardstock.)
7. On the Banner die cuts; stamp your sentiment using Real Red ink.
8. Attach your banners to your card fronts using dimensionals.

9. On the Gold Foil; die cut 2 smaller hearts and attach them to your card fronts using dimensionals.
10. Tie a double bow from a piece of the Gold Twisted Thread and attach to your card fronts using mini glue dots.
11. Attach a few of the Adhesive-backed Heart Sequins as shown.
12. On the inside of your card add a strip of the Marbled Elegance Designer Series Paper or adhere a die cut heart or stamp one.
