Friday Night Football Game Information

We are going to have our first home football game for the season this evening. In appreciation for all the support and your patience with the construction at the field, the entrance to tonight's game will be FREE. While the concession stand is not up and running, there will be food trucks onsite at the south side of the stadium. Below are some logistics in terms of parking and getting to the field:

- **Handicap Parking** – Handicapped Parking will be available and accessible behind the construction (blacktop road down from the gymnasium to the stadium). If they choose, patrons who have handicap parking can sit in their cars and watch from the elevated lot OR catch a ride in a golf cart down to the stands.
- **Parking** – Patrons will park back by the gymnasium and the baseball field. They may also choose to park in the stone parking lot by the JV softball and baseball fields and walk around the track to get to the stadium.
- **Access to Stadium** – All patrons will be funneled down the blacktop road, veer to the right on the concrete, and down the path to the south side of the stadium through the double gate.

Grade 6 Team Building Event

All of the 6th grade students participated in a team building event on Thursday, September 8th. Students started their day watching two short clips learning about what it would be like to be a chain or a chain maker in someone's life to help support them. They discussed that by being a link or a chain maker they could offer assistance by opening someone's locker, or helping another student navigate their new schedule, or just be a good listener. In the afternoon, the students were able to participate in two games, Centipede Tag & Bombardment Dodgeball. In the first game, the students learned how to work together by creating an actual chain to tag as many people as they could. In the second game, the students were working together to eliminate the other team. The day ended with a discussion wrapping up what was learned. Many students did share that they were nervous their first week of school, but by the second week they felt more comfortable due to the many links and chain makers that we have in 6th grade.

This day was created to allow students to interact with their peers whom they might have never met, learn about how to be part of a team, as well as learn about how it is important to support each other in this new adventure of middle school.
