Proof of Residence for Kearney School District

Why does the Kearney School District require Proof of Residence?

As part of our continuing effort to verify students enrolled in the Kearney School District live within our boundaries and in accordance with Missouri state law, we require all families with **new** students to provide proof of residence prior to enrollment. In addition to new students, we require incoming Kindergarteners to also provide proof of residence. Each year we will review every student's residence and may require proof of residence during Back-to-School registrations. We focus on maintaining fiscal accountability to our taxpayers and want to ensure our tax dollars are spent on KSD students. If proof of residence cannot be provided and you believe you should be enrolled at KSD, please contact your child's school or Central Office.

Acceptable Documentation

- Electric, gas, sewer, or water utility statement, dated within the last 60 days with parent(s)/guardian(s) names(s) and current address.
- Current residential lease agreement, signed by resident and landlord dated within the last 60 days.
- Residential housing contract (purchase) with possession or closing date within 90 days of the first day of school.

<u>Unacceptable Documentation</u>

- Telephone Bill
- Cable Bill
- Driver's License
- Printed Check
- General Mail
- Property Tax Receipt
- Residential Warranty Deed
- Bank Statement
- Insurance Bill
- Final, past due, or disconnect notices

All documentation received is subject to administrative approval.
