- This sheet should be the first page in your binder.
- You must be ready to submit your binder on the following dates: ___******31 de mayo ___. Each notebook check will be worth 40 points of participation.
- 1. You will need a spiral notebook for this class (it may simply be a section or two in a multi-subject spiral notebook). You should continue to use the same spiral until you run out of space, at which point you should get another. However, plan to SAVE your first spiral because you will need to submit both for your binder check.
- 2. Three ring binder though again, if necessary, you may split the binder with other classes, but make sure the Spanish section is **CLEARLY LABELED**---I should see **NO OTHER WORK** from other classes in your Spanish binder/section or notebook!!.
- 3. Any work do or notes you take in your notebook must always be clearly labeled with a **TITLE** and the **DATE** (jen español!), for example: "27/9/17; P.234 #7."

Your binder must have a minimum of 2-3 SECTIONS:

- "Calentamientos/Apuntes/Tarea del libro/*Primeros 3" ("Warm ups/notes/homework from the book/Primeros 3"): this is where you should put your spiral, in which you'll do written "calentamientos," take notes, and do exercises from the textbook.
- "Handouts": returned tests, packets, songs as well as anything else that doesn't fall under one of the above categories.
- "Vocabulario" (*OPTIONAL SECTION; this may instead be included in the "handouts" section): this will be where you will file all your vocab sheets that I give you over the semester. I would keep these all year long for reference.

If you don't hole-punch all of your papers and file them in your binder on a regular basis, then I recommend that you also have a **folder** or two to serve as your "Vocabulario" and "Handouts" sections. These could be placed behind your spiral **instead of having dividers**.

*NEW AS OF SECOND SEMESTER: You should have 7 "Primeros 3" writing activities. If you were absent or tardy, you did not do these, and there is no way to make them up. They will each be worth 1 point of your notebook check.
