



Act 1039 of 2017 Reporting by the School District (Ark. Code Ann. § 6-4-606 (b))

Dyslexia Program

Beginning in 2017, Batesville School District uses the evidenced-based Phonics First Dyslexia Intervention Program in small group intervention to address the deficit areas of students identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.

BSD employs a certified teacher on each campus that is a trained dyslexia interventionist. The district approved curriculum for dyslexia intervention is Phonics First, which is an Orton Gillingham program and is approved by the State of Arkansas.

Number of Students Who Received Dyslexia Intervention

During the 2018-2019 school year, 66 students attending Batesville School District received dyslexia intervention services from a trained dyslexia interventionist.

During the 2019-2020 school year, 47 students attending Batesville School District received dyslexia intervention services from a trained dyslexia interventionist.

During the 2020-2021 school year, 64 students attending Batesville School District received dyslexia intervention services from a trained dyslexia interventionist.

During the 2021-2022 school year, 88 students attending Batesville School District received dyslexia intervention services from a trained dyslexia interventionist.

During the 2022-2023 school year, 87 students attending Batesville School District received dyslexia intervention services from a trained dyslexia interventionist.

During the 2023-2024 school year, 84 students attending Batesville School District received dyslexia intervention services from a trained dyslexia interventionist.

During the 2024-2025 school year, 81 students attending Batesville School District received dyslexia intervention services from a trained dyslexia interventionist.

Total Number of Students Identified as Exhibiting the Characteristics of Dyslexia

During the 2018-2019 school year, 66 students attending Batesville School District were identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.

During the 2019-2020 school year, 47 students attending Batesville School District were identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.

During the 2020-2021 school year, 67 students attending Batesville School District were identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.

During the 2021-2022 school year, 91 students attending Batesville School District were identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.

During the 2022-2023 school year, 90 students attending Batesville School District were identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.
