Breakfast is served 7:15-7:45 every day. Please have your child to school before 7:40am if they plan to eat.

We've noticed an increasing number of late pick-ups after school. As a reminder, teachers and staff have scheduled meetings after school and are unable to provide supervision for students who are not picked up on time. We do have several daycare services that pick up students directly from our school and offer after-school care. If you would like a list of these services, please don't hesitate to ask at the front office. Three late pick-ups affect your child being able to participate in extracurricular activities (such as Socials).

Consistent attendance is crucial for a child's academic success. When students are absent or late, they miss out on lessons, activities, and the chance to engage with the material and their peers. It can make it harder for them to catch up, and over time, that gap can widen.
