

Son Heung-min, 'No. 2 best player in Tottenham history,' was properly recognized for his nine-year commitment

Son Heung-min (32) was named the second best player of Tottenham Hotspur history.

"Tottenham is one of the most successful clubs in England. Although there are no trophies recently, there are players who have performed outstandingly in the Premier League (PL). Considering the importance of the team, the length of stay and the record, we have decided on Tottenham's best player ranking."

The media selected nine players and comprehensively considered the importance of the team, the duration of the performance, and statistics according to the position. The list also included the name of "captain" Son Heung-min, who has been having successful seasons for as many as nine years since he wore a Tottenham uniform in 2015.

Here, Son Heung-min came in second place, facing a number of legends. He added significance in that he is the only active Tottenham player among the nine players on the list.

Son Heung-min left Bayer Leverkusen 04 in 2015 and joined Tottenham. At the time of joining the club, Tottenham did not hide its expectations by investing a large amount of transfer fee.

Son suffered ups and downs in his first year as a player, facing difficulties in the competition to become a starting member. However, he established himself as a starting member in the next year and later established himself as the ace of his team.

In particular, Harry Kane, who shared Tottenham's offense with Son Heung-min last year, became a symbol of the club itself by showing loyalty that remained in the team even though he moved to Bayern Munich.

Meanwhile, Kane was ranked first in the rankings released by the media. Gareth Bale, Luca Modric, Moussa Dembele, Christian Eriksen, Ledley King, Dele Alli and Hugo Lloris followed in that order.

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
