PROCEDURES

Bell Ringer/Dismissal: Students will complete a daily bell-ringer or sight-reading exercise to begin class. These daily assignments count as a weekly grade. If a student is absent, they should see a classmate or the teacher for the bellringer. Students are responsible for all Bellringers, even if they have been absent. Students will be dismissed by the teacher when the bell rings.
