#### 5. Legislative - Current

- **Meetings with NH Senate & Rep Staff & Federal Bills** (Carol, Ann, Darla)
  - Met with full delegation. Kuster's staff said BFFPPA was too complex but they still talked about the value of the bill. The office wants to see the path of money to munis, ie focus on economics not the environmental impact. Shared Reinmar's [presentation](#) since Molly was interested in supporting veterans.
- **Nora Bosworth - Conservation Law Foundation - [Link to Detailed Bill Analysis](#)**
  - **Container Deposit Law - [Link to Working Document with link to current bill](#)**
    - Models available around the country; more mature than EPR bills
    - PRO establishes for oversight
    - Less resistance by beverage distributors because PRO is running the system
    - PRO 'pays rent' for small retail space for redemption; scale based on size of store
    - [TOMRA](#) & [Clynk](#)
    - Unclaimed deposits will go toward recycling infrastructure & MRFs (Materials Recovery Facility)
    - **Focused Advocacy Research: rate of non-NH redemption (prohibited in bill)**
    - Advocates & Advisory Committees for env. Justice for unhoused people
    - Grant program - funded by 5% of unclaimed - education, infrastructure, litter clean up
    - Show job creation benefits
  - **EPR - Link to [Resource Document with link to current bill](#)**
    - Link to detailed explanation document (prepared by Nora Bosworth)
    - "Polluter pays" bill
    - Establishes PRO (Producer Responsibility Organization) with existing non-profit, 10 year contract, managed by DES
    - Producers must prove compliance;
    - Companies <\$1 mil & <1 ton of packaging exempt but must prove
    - PRO has hefty list of responsibilities along with DES including a publicly accessible needs assessment
    - Data - recycling rates, non-compliant producer list
    - Fees - incentivizes reuse and refill systems, recycled products, enhanced recycling, but NOT replacing packaging with lighter plastic products
    - **Research Needed: Chemicals banned in packaging; need to check whether the chemicals are already banned in NH; need a resource that summarizes toxicity of each chemical; this may help counter pushback; Christina & Nora can help with this**
    - **SUGGEST: Granite State Poll to determine which towns are eliminating recycling - Kristine will coordinate**

## 6. Updates from Ten Towns, Ten Actions Leaders & Attendees

- **Ann - Chester:** Renewal Compost program continuing in Town; working on grants with school to initiate a food scrap collection program; Bonnie Bethune (NRRRA) lives in Chester; January 8: Recycling 101 for Chester residents; talk about hazards of chemical recycling; encourages trash pick ups for making connections & education; “Do What You Love”; planted beach grass at Hampton Beach; starting Indigenous Gardens in Exeter & Manchester;
- **Bruce - Keene:** Lempster is evaluating whether to discontinue plastics recycling
- **Carol Foss - Collaborative Solid Waste Strategies** - attended SW Working Group meeting; will share notes; [new DES website](#); currently negotiating for a ‘waste characterization study’ and studying food waste generators and recycling improvements; DES Rules Revisions on SWM; meetings coming up; 2021-22 SW Report coming out soon
- **Carol Sullivan - Center Harbor:** Energy Committee; needs contacts who are supportive of energy initiatives; hosting public hearings on solar initiatives; saves Town money & for taxpayers
- **Christina - Portsmouth:** Met with the Portsmouth Eco-club who is going to help the STS campaign at local and state level through social media, LTEs, restaurant meetings and will attend the hearing or submit testimony when the time comes for Rep. Caplan’s bill. Working with Kristine to confirm our 4 restaurants for Reusable Seacoast and met with Reusable San Mateo.
- **Cindy - Cornish Flat:** continuing mesh bag distribution; Co-op transitioning to corn based packaging
- **George - Bow:** strong recycling program in Bow; Thailand is taking over plastics recycling that China used to do
- **Kate - Hudson:** Town looking at discontinuing recycling; how to address; signed on to Community Power; all reps are Republicans; economics is the primary conversation
- **Kristine - Dover:** Dover Plastic Reduction Group conducted a priorities poll to see where the group should focus and who would like to participate; legislative activities emerged as #1; many who will participate in research; testifying in Concord; 10 people want to be involved in restaurant project; CA pilot coordinator is sharing information;
- **Mary - Harrisville:** Rethink Plastics meeting on Wednesday; plugged Skip the Stuff campaign in local newsletter; Mesh Bag Mama handout at Market Basket; December 14; discontinuing plastic bag film collection after 3rd bench; Harrisville is looking to switch from simply using Monadnock Disposal Service back to Recycling. A rep on the Committee that runs our Transfer Station will be giving our team an update. Once the warrant article is prepared - there may be info on it that could help Kate Messner.
- **Raeline - Nottingham:** Looking for guidance on where to start - list of actions suggested.
- **George - Bow:** Thank you for this thoughtful working group. Bow has an active recycling program, yet my concern is that much of it doesn’t get recycled, especially plastics. I saw a program, on NPR I believe, that showed a foreign country that does much plastic recycling and they stated that only about 25% of it actually gets recycled. So the repackaging work is a strong goal for the future.
- **Nancy - Bristol:** Bristol is having programs at the library. We are just starting to have something every month in our local paper and we are still working on getting all organizations in town to use less plastic when they have events. Our local Hannafords is a good partner that we need to use more.
- **Patsy - Nelson:** Christina presented to NH HWCA Policy and Advocacy WG; attended Solid Waste Working Group; Paige Wilson has A-Z recycling page on DES website <https://www.des.nh.gov/waste/solid-waste/managing-my-waste>; not much info on plastics; Movie Night Feb. 1 on Plastics. Attended meeting to comment on the NH Climate Action Plan. <https://www.des.nh.gov/climate-and-sustainability/climate-change/climate-pollution-reduction-grants>
- **Peter - Dover:** perception of DES procedures and rules are ‘50 years behind’; will investigate this claim; active citizens are a credit to their communities; need more people to become actively engaged
