## Fall Parent/Teacher Conferences Sign-Up (sign-ups close Oct. 3)

Fall Conferences will be held in person, Thursday October 9 and Tuesday October 14 at Fernwood. These sign-up links will close THIS FRIDAY October 3, after that, please reach out to teachers directly to schedule or reschedule.

#### Sign-Up Guidelines:

- All conferences will take place in classrooms.
- District <u>language translation services</u> are available, you may also contact your child's teacher or Ms. Kari at <u>hansonks@milwaukee.k12.wi.us</u> for assistance.
- If you have more than one child at Fernwood, please consider allowing some "travel time" between your conferences.
- Please sign up for only ONE conference time slot for each of your K3-6th grade students. (We understand that some students may have two households. In order to accommodate all families, we ask that only one conference slot be signed up per student.)
- If you have an Adolescent student (7th or 8th grade), please sign up for a 30 minute timeslot. Conferences with each teacher must be limited to 5 efficient minutes to ensure everyone can meet with all the teachers. There will be 10 families signing up for each timeslot which means there will be some waiting.
- Childcare will not be provided, please plan accordingly.
