Basic Information Needed:

Who: Key person/people

What: What happened? What was that person pursuing?

When: Date event occurred? Date range when this person impacted society?

Where: Primary location?

Why: Why is this person/event significant?

How: How did this person accomplish their goal?

Notable Quotable: Find one famous quote from or about person/event and explain the meaning of it.

Better (B)

Distinguish background information that helps better understand the event/person.

Identify obstacles person/event faced; explain how person/event was able to persevere.

Investigate people who influenced person/event.

Best (A)

Analyze the effects the person/event had on society during the 1930s and today

Determine conflicts created or solved by person/event.

Explain how society today would be different without this person/event.
