NARRATIVE REPORT

Participation of SSLG in LYDO Annual Investment Plan AIP WORKSHOP

I. Introduction

In support of youth participation in governance and community development pursuant to Republic Act No. 10742 (Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015), which strengthens youth involvement in planning and policy-making, and Republic Act No. 8044 (Youth in Nation-Building Act), which promotes the active role of youth in national and local development, the Local Youth Development Office (LYDO) of Teresa successfully conducted the Annual Investment Plan (AIP) Planning Workshop for 2027 on February 19–20, 2026, held in Los Baños, Laguna.

The activity gathered youth leaders and representatives from various youth-serving organizations across the Municipality of Teresa, including student leaders such as members of the Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG).
