HISTORY. [HC]

- Gregor is born in 266AC, Sandor follows about five years later in 271AC
- Lady Clegane and a middleborn girl named Elinor die around 276AC
- Gregor is, at the behest of Tywin Lannister, knighted by Prince Rhaegar Targaryen in 281AC
- In 282AC, Lord Clegane dies in a hunting accident. Gregor inherits the Clegane lands, incomes, and titles.
- Sandor flees Clegane Keep on foot the same day. He arrives in Casterly Rock and pledges
 his service to Lord Tywin Lannister. He is given special attention as a Clegane, specifically
 trained and urged towards loyalty to his liege lord.
- Later, at 12 years old (283AC), as part of Lord Tywin's host, Sandor kills his first man. He
 never stepped foot inside the Red Keep, and was squiring for a revolving door of Lannister
 cousins at the time.
- In 289AC, Sandor fights in the Greyjoy rebellion, and, shocking just about everybody on the planet, declines Knighthood. This act inspires Tywin to assign him as a personal guard to Queen Cersei.
- Cersei assigns Sandor to be young Prince Joffrey's personal shield.
- Now living in King's Landing full time, and word of The Hound spreading and growing more infamous, Sandor commissions Tobho Mott to forge his hound's head helm. 290AC.
- In 298AC, Sandor battles his brother at The Tourney of the Hand. The fight is halted before either brother can grievously harm the other. Loras Tyrell names Sandor champion in gratitude for saving his life.
- Sandor deserts his post during the Battle of Blackwater in 299AC.
- Gregor is killed by Oberyn Martell in combat. His skull is cleaned and sent to Dorne.
- Sandor is left for dead on the bank of The Trident by Arya Stark in 300AC.
- A day or so later, Sandor is found by the Elder Brother of the nearby sept of the Quiet Isle.
 Fevered and dying, he spends hours confessing his sins, weeping, and begging for mercy.
- A new Gravedigger is appointed at the Quiet Isle.

At the age of eleven, Sandor Clegane fled his family's keep and made his way, on foot, to Casterly Rock. There, he pledged service to Lord Tywin, who saw talent in the younger brother of his favored battering ram, Gregor. You could train a dog to kill, and may as well teach a boy the same. Hungry to prove himself, to be better than, to distinguish himself from his butcher of a brother, Sandor became one of the greatest fighters in Westeros. Unfailingly loyal, obedient to the last, and with seemingly few to no qualms about killing, Tywin succeeding in breeding two highly trained attack dogs in the form of the Clegane boys. For nearly two decades, Sandor lived and breathed as The Hound- a Lannister dog, and nothing more.

Time passed, fact gave way to legend, and legend gave way to myth, until it was all but forgotten. Four thousand years later, an archeological dig unearths a great crypt in the deep north, and the dead began to return.

King's Landing is still a cesspool of debauchery and political backstabbing, and ancient families still like to throw the weight of their money around. Sandor Clegane used to be entrenched in it, working security for the powerful

Lannister/Baratheon clan. He was a man feared for his stature, demeanor, and talent for intimidation-not to mention his unflappable loyalty. Mostly unflappable, anyway, an estate fire triggered a somewhat massive mental break for the man, and after a few adventures involving a teenage wolf-girl, a handful of bar fights, and alcohol poisoning on the side of the road, he's left that world far behind. This is a Sandor who was removed from the Clegane home as a young man and lived in foster care for the majority of his teen years. After leaving employment of the Lannister, he reunited with his foster father, who helped get him into therapy. Modern medicine, mental healthcare, and a support system have made this a much more well-adjusted Sandor than in historical Westeros.

THE ELDER BROTHER (RAY)



Ray, the Elder Brother of the Sept on the Quiet Isle, is, in many ways, a man from another time. Strong of heart and body, he is both a medicine man and spiritual leader, talented in the health of body and mind. Ray found Sandor beneath a tree on the Trident after several days of exposure. He was fevered, dying, delirious, and begging for the mercy of death- but Ray refused him. The Elder Brother instead cleaned him, tended his wounds, and held Sandor in his arms while the man wept and confessed all his misdeeds. It is thanks to him that the Hound was buried, and Sandor Clegane survived. (In Modern 'verse, Ray is/was Sandor's foster father during

his teen years. He is a dearly needed support and shoulder while Sandor got sober and entered therapy.)

STRANGER



Stranger is an ill-tempered, violent, and difficult to control courser that belongs to Sandor Clegane. He is incredibly large, as befits his equally tall rider, and seems to be some draft breed. As a warhorse, he has been trained to kick, bite, and fear little. He's been known to bite fingers and ears off people who try to take his lead, but for Sandor he's as soft and gentle as an old gelding.
