

Livestock Market Sale Rules

1. Market Divisions are open to active Pope County 4-H and FFA members.
2. Exhibitors must have had possession of their market animal for a minimum of 60 days (excluding poultry and rabbits).
3. The sale of the Market Animals is under the supervision of the Pope County Fair Market Sale Superintendent.
4. If an exhibitor qualifies for Market Sale with more than 1 animal, they must select and submit to the Livestock Superintendent which animal will be shown in the Market Sale by Thursday at 9pm. If no selection is made by deadline, it will default to the market animal with the highest show ranking. Should an animal be disqualified for any reason, the next place animal in the show will be named.
5. Market Sale order will be determined by the judge officiating in each market show.
6. The Market Sale will be based on current year entries of each market species exhibited or the maximum stated in each species market division rules.
7. Exhibitors are responsible for seeing that their animal enters the ring at the appropriate time.
8. No substitutions will be allowed for market sale entries.
9. Exhibitors must show their own animal during the Market Sale. For extenuating circumstances see the Livestock General Rules and the Livestock Superintendent.
