- West Side of the venue for cocktails and dancing while the ceremony and dancing is in the skylight room
- Ten screens are provided to hide pre-set tables OR we can hire a team for pipe and draping
- Includes 200 wood chairs, 8x42 wood tables, (2) 6 x30 wood tables, 4 hightop tables, 4 low cocktail tables, lounge/soft seating sets, DJ booth, plants, kitchen prep tables, pre-installed Italian café lights, sound, access to private green room/wedding suite
- DIY décor must be pre-approved by the venue. Ladder to be used has to be by someone who is insured with a COI. Early setup access begins at \$200 an hour
- No nails, screws, staples, penetrating items used on the walls, floors, or ceiling. No sparklers allowed
- No glitter, foil, or paper confetti, loose candy or similar items. **Only low tack tape is allowed on the walls and floors.**
- Candles are permitted but must be self-contained with no open flame to prevent wax from dipping on furniture and floors. **Wood tables used for buffets must have linens.**
- **There is no vendor parking available**
- **We can get ready in the space for \$250 an hour 3-hours before the event**

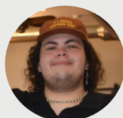

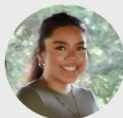

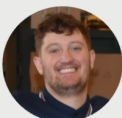

Note: Flip traditional placement (bride on stage right and groom on stage left - bride's good side is her left side lol)

- 2x roses
- Cord
- Candle
- Lighter/matches
- 2x vow books
- Rings with ring bearer

1. Processional (5 minutes)

- a. Officiant Mike and Matron of Honor Melanie
- b. Song 1: Mom, Dad, Oliver *Golden Hour* by JVKE
- c. Pair #1 - Mira and Cristian
- d. Pair #2 - Vivian and Tommy
- e. Pair #3 - Chelsea and Geo
- f. Pair #4 - Adriana and Edwin
- g. Pair #5 - Amy and Marcus
- h. Pair #6 - Rubi and Liam
- i. Song 2: Mom, Dad, Alex *Turning Page* by *Sleeping at Last*

2. Officiant opening remarks (2 minutes)

- a. Mike opens
- b. Mike introduces Melanie, Matron of Honor/Sister of Groom

3. [Rose ceremony](#) (3 minutes)

- a. Melanie: The love that Oliver and Alex feel for one another is a seed that their parents planted in their hearts years ago – and today it has blossomed. Today, as they embrace each other in their love, they also embrace the families, which have come together on this happy occasion. As a sign of their love for their families, Oliver and Alex would like to offer these roses to their mothers as symbols of their eternal love. These Roses are a promise that no matter how far away you are – that you are not forgotten and that you are always in their hearts.
- b. (Instruction: GROOM/BRIDE and GROOM/BRIDE present a flower to Oliver's mother first, and then to Alex's mother.)

4. [Cord ceremony](#) (3 minutes)

- a. Mike: Oliver and Alex, I invite Mira and Chelsea to place a cord over you. This cord symbolizes an infinite bond of love you share that keeps your relationship strong in the face of adversity, as well as that you both are no longer two, but one in marriage. May

this cord remind you to face your life together courageously and to be mutual in support of each other in carrying out your duties and responsibilities as a couple. And, may your love grow stronger and bind you closer together through the years.

- b. (Instruction: Mira will place the cord over BRIDE's head and rest it on his/her shoulders, while Chelsea will place the cord over GROOM's head and rest it on his/her shoulders.)
5. Removal of cord (1 minute)
 - a. Officiant: I would like to call Mira and Chelsea to remove the cord and veil.
6. Exchange of vows (6 minutes)
 - a. Alex (3 minutes)
 - b. Oliver (3 minutes)
7. I do's (3 minutes)
8. Exchange of rings (3 minutes)
 - a. Ring bearer brings rings
9. [Unity candle](#) (3 minutes)
 - a. Liam: Today you have decided to share the rest of your lives with each other. This beautiful union is now symbolized by the lighting of the Unity Candle. The candle you are about to light is a candle of Marriage.
 - b. The individual candles represent all that you are and all that you have been until this moment. It is a candle of Unity because both candles must come together to create the new light. Its fire is miraculous because it represents the light of two people in love. This candle is also a candle of Commitment because it takes two people working together to keep it ablaze. GROOM/BRIDE and GROOM/BRIDE please light the center candle to symbolize the union of your lives.
 - c. Liam: Today, as you have lit this candle, may the brightness of the flame shine throughout your lives together. May the twinkle of this one light be a testimony of your union. May this candle burn brightly as a symbol of your love and commitment to each other.
10. Officiant closing remarks (2 minutes)
11. Kiss (1 minute)
 - a. You may kiss your spouse.
 - b. I would like to introduce the happy couple, Oliver and Alexandria Berganos
12. Recessional
 - a. *Dive by Olivia Dean*
