- Junior in high school (11th grader) at time of application
- Currently hold a 4.0 weighted GPA or above
- Enrolled in Algebra II, Trigonometry or above
- Demonstrate financial need
- Have taken Advanced Placement/International Baccalaureate courses, if offered
- Actively enrolled in a high school curriculum within the U.S. or U.S. territories

We offer the program at no cost to students or families. USC will pay for transportation to and from campus for students coming from outside of Southern California.

This year, the summer intensive runs from July 10, 2022 through July 30, 2022

If selected, each Bovard Scholar will have one full year of support through the admissions cycle and spend three weeks on the USC campus, where they will receive:

- Personalized career exploration
- Expert admission and financial aid support
- Comprehensive test preparation
- Leadership development
