Deer

Deer are four-legged ruminant mammal of the family Cervidae. They are known for their majestic antlers. They are herbivorous animals who feed primarily on leaves. There are around 34 species of deer in the world and they inhabited various regions except Antarctica and Australia. They tend to live in a dense forest where they can easily hide from the predator.

The body of a deer is similar to the body of an antelope with slim body and long legs. They are characterized by their branched and long antlers on their head. The antlers are the extension of their skull. It is made of true bone and it is not permanent. It can be removed and

regrown each year. The surfaces of the antlers are covered with an exterior sheath made of hair follicles. Mostly, only male deer possess antlers, but female from some species also have them.

The largest deer can grow up to 2.6 m in height with the body weight of 800 kg. Meanwhile the smallest species can grow up to the size of 35 cm with the body weight of 6 kg. They have four long and powerful legs that allow them to be a good runner and jumper, and they also have two long ears and a short tail. Each species has different coat color, some of them are: reddish brown, dark brown and gray. Beside that, several species appear to have brown coat with white spots on it.

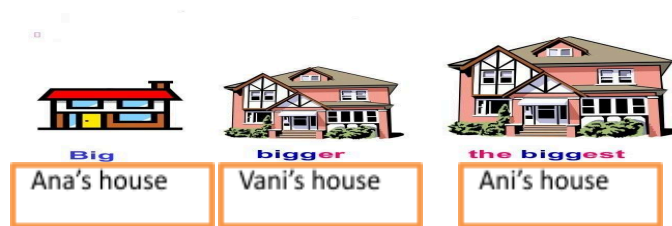
