

## Marketing & Event Committees 6/11/2024 DRAFT MINUTES

PRESENT: Louise, Jackson, Karla, Denise, Meggie, Evan, Katherine

Denise moved to approve <u>Draft Minutes of 2/13/2024 Meeting</u>. Meggie seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Katherine went over the Merchant Feedback and Guest Feedback from the Arts & Craft Crawl, which was generally quite good. Katherine and Amy will go over the P&L for the event and issue a check for the donation to Evanston Made.

Katherine went over 2024 Wine Walk Updates. Hive Center for Book Arts is notified and ready to go! Pre-Sale tickets went on sale June 7, and 10 tickets have been sold so far. Six businesses recruited so far (3 on Main-Chicago, 3 on Dempster-Chicago), need 12-15 on each end.

Katherine went over Summer 2024 events.

Where's Waldo Returns in July! It's a scavenger hunt, sponsored by Booked, lasts all July long. MDM recruits 20+ businesses and prints passports, then it culminates in a party at Booked where people turn in their passports and get prizes. It's a great way to get foot traffic into stores during the slower summer months.

Sidewalk Sale July 26-28. Henry's Hoarder's Heaven (Secret Treasures) Sidewalk Sale is back, will be the centerpiece of the Dempster-Chicago sale. Rainbows for All Children will hold a sidewalk sale fundraiser in their alley, also on the Dempster-Chicago side. Need to activate Main Street extra -- "Where the hell is our Sidewalk" Sale / "Look at our brand new Sidewalk" Sale. Katherine asked the committee for ideas. Katherine is checking with Evanston Pride to see if we can do a Pridewalk Sale with their maker's market people. Construction item related scavenger hunt for families on the south sidewalk?

Katherine updated the committee on Marketing/Communications for Main Street during Construction.

There are banners up on the CTA tracks,

- MDM has purchased two new wind signs purchased and distributed on Main St,
- New banner going up in Grey Park presently
  - MDM continues to promote Main St shopping
    - o Neighbor Newsletters
    - o Support Evanston Shops page
    - o MDM social media
    - o City of Evanston includes "Support Main St" messages at least once a month in their e-news

Katherine notified the committee that MDM may have the opportunity to create a possible extra festival – the contractor will have to shut down the 700 Block of Main St for 3-4 days when the raised crosswalk goes in. We could conceivably have a band and a small festival that weekend (we would have to take that \$\$ out of reserves, or out of our October festival funds). Katherine will continue to monitor the possibilities.

"Return of Custer Fair" festival October 20<sup>th</sup> – plans continue with Rotary. The Pirons will do s'mores if we can get Parks & Rec to donate their firepits woot!

NEW BUSINESS: A local marketing consultant has asked us to consider putting our social media consulting out for bid again. The committee agreed to move forward.
