Q: For the written exam, watching videos and studying slides are enough to get the maximum score(13 scores)?

A: Yes, the written exam covers what we did during the lectures. It may also ask you for applying some concepts, e.g., to apply Nielsen's heuristics to a provided user interface. Please, have a look at the past exams available in the course webpage.

Q: We should give oral exam and project delivery before the written exam which is 28 of January?

A: The oral exam (that is the project presentation) is on a separate date from the written exam. It could be before or after the written exam: in February, it will be after.

Q: Do we need to show the demo in a computer browser or on a mobile phone?

A: As you prefer. If you can show us the prototype on your target device is probably more effective and "realistic".

Q: How can we test our web app in a mobile browser?

A: Several ways. You can use ngrok (<https://ngrok.com>), put the web application on Heroku (<https://www.heroku.com>), access to the node server from your local network, etc.

Q: Do we need to have the oral and written exam in the same session?

A: Nope, they are independent. They only need to be both passed before the end of the semester.

Q: Can we refuse the written exam grade?

A: Until both parts (written + oral exams) are not done and you are not saying to us "*please, register*", we are not doing to register the final grade. So, you can take the written exam, keep the score (if positive) and decide to try it in another session. In that case, if you deliver your written exam and you have a previous (sufficient) grade, the new score replaces the old one, in any case (so, even if you got an insufficient score). If you don't submit your written test, you will keep the old grade, instead.

Q: Can we use the up-to-dated versions of icons in our prototype and change the wireframe (which had a different version of icons), or we have to only implement the UI elements in the wireframe with same design?

A: You can change icons, as it was not the goal of the wireframe to have the final appearance.

Q: For the oral exam, is there the possibility of coinciding with other exams of other courses?

A: It might happen, but we will try to avoid it and accommodate groups (e.g., by shifting their turn some hours later or before).

Q: When we'll know the date of oral exam?

A: On January, for the February session. A few weeks before an exam session, for the others.

Q: Will we have a lab text to follow for usability testing?

A: Yes, a text and a template for M4.
