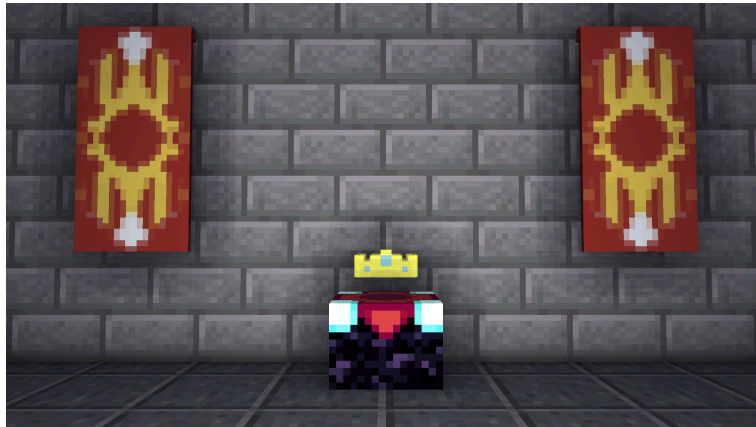


Lore of Inamortia



Centuries prior to the present day of Inamortia, there was a major Platian nation known as the **Mortius Empire**, a nation of mankind ruled by **Emperor Charlemagne**. Although the Mortius Empire was prosperous under his rule, the **Illagers** felt oppressed under his rule, as the emperor was deemed intolerant to them. In addition, there were a myriad of other secluded civilizations of exotic sapients such as the **Wingidons** of the mountains, **Molefolks** and **Rascals** of the caves, **Cetosapiens** and **Orcas** of the seas, and **Islander Elephants** of the islands.

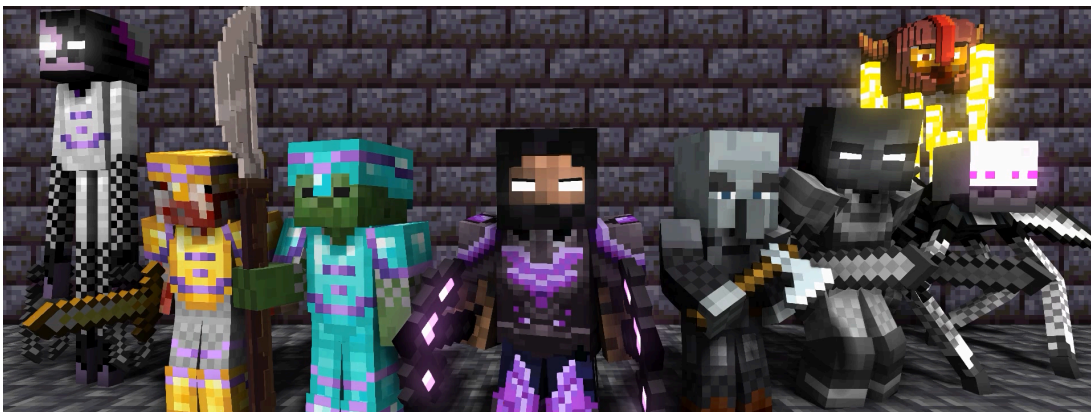
In Netheria, six sapients proliferated, the **Pigman**, **Piglin**, **Witherkin**, **Blaze**, **Tacul**, and **Trunk-Arm**. The witherkin were known to be a sadistic and tribal race, often attacking innocent nether villages. The pigmen, on the other hand, were more civilized, forming bastions to defend against the barbaric witherkin. They also met with the Mortius Empire, who often traded Platian commodities for Netherian items such as fungi and netherite. The Witherkin treated the Platian newcomers like pigmen, killing them and plundering their riches for their own interest. Piglins and Blazes were neutral, though the former were more aligned with the pigmen while the latter with the Witherkin. Taculs and Trunk-Arms were fully neutral, staying out from the conflict in the ceilings and dense forestry respectively.

Meanwhile, Enderia was isolated from the two others, but sapients still prospered on this planet. There were seven sapients of Enderia: **Enderman**, **Shulkin**, **Warplin**, **Deltacrawler**, **Chros**, **Dracos**, and **Floatling**. They all live in their own landmasses, separated by the vast abyssal ocean (except for Floatlings, who instead call the abyss as home)



However, the serenity ended when an ambitious entity rose in power, **Herobrine**. Formerly a human miner, he unknowingly gained powers that allowed him to command exotic lightning and raise an army of his own, at first composed of the Undead. Soon, the Illager factions joined Herobrine's cause, who then genetically modified their physical bruteness and resilience.

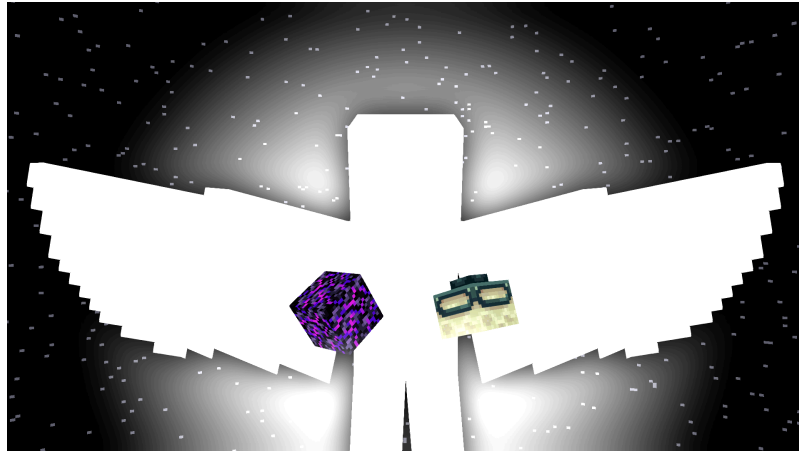
However, even his army of reanimated corpses and genetic brutes was still not enough to challenge the empire. Herobrine was forced to retreat to Netheria and immediately expanded his conquest to the other planets, massacring the pigmen in the Nether and zombifying many of them for his army. The Witherkin and most blazes joined Herobrine's cause willingly. Then in Enderia, the Deltacrawlers willingly joined, while other ender sapients resisted and were hunted down, countless of Endermen were zombified. In addition, Herobrine corrupted a large female tyrant dragon, transforming her into the **Primarch Dragon**, blessed with larger size and the ability to breath burning purple thunder.



With his new massive army, Herobrine's Legion were able to defeat the Mortius Empire. The mankind fought hard, but they were no match against the Legion's overwhelming army. With Emperor Charlemagne's death at the hands of Herobrine, the Mortius Empire crumbled and Herobrine had successfully achieved his ambition to rule not only Platia, but also Netheria and Enderia.

Herobrine reigned with terror in the three worlds for years, forming an ultimate dystopian world. Many sapients were hunted for food and driven to near-extinction. The dystopian

world ensued for years, until the **Legendary Heroes**, warriors who were said to be chosen and blessed by the enigmatic entity Ruth, tackled Herobrine's army and managed to revoke his powers, ultimately defeating him.



After his defeat, the legendary heroes condensed Herobrine's powers in a small cube (later known in the legends as the Orb of Dominance) and hid it in a mysterious cave, so no one can ever find it again. Decades after Herobrine's fall, a villager **Vardoclya Rutherford** established a new nation from the ashes of the Mortius Empire, proclaiming herself as the **Queen of the Vardoclya Kingdom**, predominantly composed of villagers. Not long after, the remaining humans founded the **Central Kingdom** under the rule of **King George Central**. Meanwhile Netheria and Enderia also started to heal, and new civilizations began to rise from the ashes of the old. It was not until centuries later **Lord Zandalfor Baskrada** established the **Obsardis Kingdom**, which united all Illagers of the Obsardis region who were once barbaric races constantly engaging in brutal civil wars.
